

A Biblical View OF THE END TIMES

TRACING THE LINEAGE OF THE GIANTS

Week #8; Jan. 18, 2026, 6PM

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Review

- We've laid a strong foundation in our study of **Gen. 3:15** and **Gen. 6:1-4**.
- If we don't get the intentions of these passages in **Genesis** right, then all prophetic matters from this point forward will rest on a shaky foundation.
- Furthermore, Jesus said Himself in **Matt. 24:37** “....as it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man.”
- We're taking Jesus' words seriously in this series. To properly understand the events that lie ahead of us, we must properly understand the events that lie behind us.

NOTE: In **Isaiah 46:9-10**, God declares, “**Remember what happened LONG AGO**, for I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like Me. I make known the end **FROM the beginning**, **FROM ancient times**, what is **STILL to come**. I say, ‘My purpose will stand, and I will do all that I please.’”

- A key takeaway is the future is connected to the past. Therefore, we MUST understand **Genesis** well if we're going to get things right in **Revelation**. The roof of a house rests on its foundation.
- That's why last week's lesson focused on unpacking the willful misinterpretations which have sprung up around **Gen. 6:1-4**.
- We've seen how the apostles and the early church fathers agreed with the literal interpretive positions **we have taken** in this series.
 - We noted that these early church leaders made these same views clear in their own writings, as well as in those books of the Bible which some of them were inspired to write (**Cf. 2 Peter, Jude, Et al.**).
 - We also saw these same positions were recorded in *The Ante-Nicene Fathers, Volume 8* – this was a comprehensive compilation of the early Christian church's views, writings, and doctrines that was published mid-late 1800's.
 - It is **beyond question** that a literal interpretation of Scripture – which is the same approach WE are taking in this series - was the approach of the early church.
- We also learned how some of the later church fathers like Augustine, Martin Luther, and John Calvin decided to take a DIFFERENT approach.
 - They took a different approach because the historical record shows they had certain biases. They didn't want to yield to everything the Bible was saying.

- These folks – and others in their wake – actively pushed a ‘symbolic’ or ‘allegorical’ interpretation of key parts and themes of Scripture.
- This was irresponsible, and it led to views like Replacement Theology and the ‘sons of Seth’ theory.
- Their conclusions not only go against the plain intentions of God’s Word, but they led to profound antisemitism and mishandling of Bible prophecy.
- It’s why many church leaders today – **particularly** in the Reformed, Catholic, and Orthodox denominations – do not have accurate views of Bible prophecy, do not have accurate views of Israel – (and **sadly, all too often**, do not have accurate views of God).
- They’ve leaned their ladders against clouds. They disproportionately esteem their denominational origins. Like Augustine, Luther and Calvin before them, they also wish to cling to their personal biases.

NOTE: But -- **WE** are going to stay focused on PROPER interpretive principles in this series.

- **WE** are going to stand on the fact that the Bible means what it says, and it says what it means.
- And that’s why we’ve learned that the **physical seed** of Satan will be at ongoing war with the **physical seed** of the woman.
- This is what God Himself made clear when He pronounced His judgements on Satan in the in the Garden of Eden.
- Satan knew, from that point, that his eventual destruction would come through a Messiah who has uncorrupted **human** genetics.
- And so, we see in the account of **Gen. 6:1-4** that Satan and his fallen angels first set their sights against all humans.
- Not knowing any more than what God had said in the Garden of Eden, Satan sought to corrupt the genome of all humanity (he used a shotgun approach to broadly attack the biggest possible target).

NOTE: The Book of Enoch goes into some details here regarding this incursion.

NOTE: What I’m about to say may upset some of you, but remember, The Book of Enoch is quoted in the Bible by Jude and Peter.

- It was studied and respected by the early church fathers, and it was found with The Dead Sea Scrolls in the Qumran area which is where the Essenes had lived.
- The Essenes – unlike the apostate Pharisees, Sadducees, and Scribes of Jesus’ time – faithfully held to Scripture. They were scholars of Bible prophecy too.
- There are some convincing arguments that John the Baptist was an Essene.
- The Book of Enoch is **not** inspired canon, but it lends good historical background and details to things we read in the Bible.
- The Book of Enoch records that 200 fallen angels – called ‘watchers’ – descended on Mt. Hermon in northern Israel. This is the area of the Golan Heights.

- They had ‘leader angels’ among them who persuaded the rest of these fallen angels to violate their heavenly abode, to gratify their lust for women, and to produce giant progeny (or Nephilim) by these women.
- According to The Book of Enoch, these fallen angels taught humanity forbidden arts and knowledge (herbalism, sorceries and enchantments, astrology, and weapons and warfare, among others).
- Their actions caused immense corruption, violence, and disruption. The Book of Enoch describes how God intervened and imprisoned these fallen angels for future judgement.
- In fact, two passages in the Bible, in quoting The Book of Enoch, say the very same thing:

(Cf. 2 Peter 2:4-5): “*For if God did not spare the angels when they sinned, but cast them deep into hell, placing them in chains of darkness to be held for judgment; if He did not spare the ancient world when He brought the flood on its ungodly people, but preserved Noah, a preacher of righteousness, among the eight;”*

(Cf. Jude vs. 6): “*And the angels who did not keep their positions of authority but abandoned their proper dwelling—these he has kept in darkness, bound with everlasting chains for judgment on the great Day.”*

- NOTE: There are NO good reasons to disagree with any of these details which The Book of Enoch provides.
- Various passages in Scripture support each point I’ve stated here, but do your own study and draw your own conclusions. (Always be as the Bereans in **Acts 17:11**).
- I will add here that Dr. Ken Johnson has many EXCELLENT studies on The Book of Enoch, the Dead Sea Scrolls, the Essenes, and so on. His website (biblefacts.org) is an outstanding and clarifying resource for your personal study.
- **(Getting back to our quick review here):** In all this developing mayhem, we saw that the Bible states in **Gen. 6:9** that Noah was found to be ‘*perfect in his generations.*’
- We learned by applying the proper rules of interpretation that this means Noah was genetically untainted. He was physically pure. He had ‘survived’ the fallen angelic agenda.
- Because Noah was a righteous man, he married a woman who was also physically pure. That means their three sons were genetically uncorrupted too.
- In fact, we KNOW this was the case because Jesus descends through the line of Shem, one of Noah’s sons.
- Jesus arrived, as God prophesied in the Garden of Eden, through UNCORRUPTED human genetics.
- But around Noah’s time – nearly all the rest of humanity had been tainted by the fallen angelic genome (the ‘zera’ [zeh-RAH] first mentioned in **Gen. 3:15**).

- We learned that things had become SO bad by Noah's time, that **Gen. 6:12** tells us “*....all flesh had become corrupted.*”
- We cannot overestimate how bad the situation had become. The entirety of God's Creation had been turned upside down. Evil, depravity, and total violence reigned.
- This was due to what Satan and the fallen angels had brought about. They had bred the Nephilim giants who were hybrid entities – part angelic, and part human.
- These Nephilim had overrun the earth and decimated humanity. That's why God sent The Great Flood. He needed to scrub the planet of this unredeemable race of giants.
- The Great Flood was not sent because God lost His cool in a manner that was out of His character. That's more-or-less how most of us have been taught to think.
- The worldwide flood was God's way of rebooting humanity and preserving the Messianic promise. It was God's way of ensuring His plan of salvation for you and me.
- The Great Flood was God's countermove, if you will, against Satan's efforts to prevent his own eventual destruction.

A. Today, we are going to learn how the Nephilim - these hybrid entities that were part fallen angel and part human - returned AFTER The Great Flood.

NOTE: Look at the first part of Gen. 6:4 -- “and also afterward...”

1. Again, in the pursuit of proper Biblical interpretation, we must evaluate the context of everything we read.
 - **Chapter 6 of Genesis** describes the cause of The Great Flood.
 - The CAUSE of The Great Flood – as we've seen – was the widespread corruption of human genetics by the fallen angels.
 - The CAUSE was the preservation of the pure human genome, and the preservation of the Messianic promise.
 - The CAUSE was to keep God's plan for our salvation intact.
2. And so, when we read that the Nephilim were on the earth 'after that' as well, we need to ask ourselves, 'After what?'
 - And the context, both immediate and larger, connects the entry of the Nephilim with God's decision **to send The Great Flood**.
 - These two elements – the fallen angel incursion AND the Flood - are in a direct relationship. That's patently evident right here in **Genesis Ch. 6**.
 - This connection is also evident in **2 Peter 2:4-5** which I read earlier. Pay attention now as I read that passage once more and as I emphasize several things:

*“For if God did not spare the angels **when they sinned**, but cast them deep into hell, **placing them in chains of darkness to be held for judgment**; if He did not spare the ancient world **when He brought the flood** on its ungodly people, but **preserved Noah**, a preacher of righteousness, among the eight;”*

- The direct connections are made here:
 - The Nephilim invaded the earth and nearly took it over completely.
 - God incarcerated these fallen angels who violated His created order (more info on this later in this series).
 - God sends The Great Flood to reboot humanity and to preserve the Messianic promise.
 - God spares Noah and seven others in the process.
3. So, an important question arises, “How can we explain the re-emergence of the Nephilim – the hybrid giants – AFTER The Great Flood?”
- Let’s make sure we get TWO truths established first:
 - **Number one**, the Nephilim DID return AFTER The Great Flood (**Gen. 6:4** makes that very clear – as does the rest of Scripture).
 - We see giants in several Biblical accounts AFTER The Great Flood, so this is not even a point worth debating.
 - **Number two**, The Great Flood destroyed everything on ‘earth’ that was NOT in the ark (**Cf. Gen. 7:20-24; – Again, note my emphases**).

*“The waters rose and covered the mountains to a depth of more than fifteen cubits [that’s roughly 23-25 feet]. Every living thing **that moved on land** perished—birds, livestock, wild animals, all the creatures that swarm **over the earth**, and **all mankind**. Everything **on dry land that had the breath of life in its nostrils** died. Every living thing on **the face of the earth** was wiped out; **people and animals** and the **creatures that move along the ground** and **the birds** were wiped **from the earth**. Only Noah was left, and those with him in the ark. The waters flooded the earth for a hundred and fifty days.”*

- The Bible is painstakingly clear. We cannot make any argument that any living thing **that was land based** outside of the ark survived The Great Flood!
- But it IS worth noting that perhaps the fish and the sea creatures are not included in this passage. The Bible seems to suggest that these categories of the animal kingdom were not on the ark.
- (That’s a rabbit trail for you to study on your own, and for you to draw your own conclusions about...)

NOTE: Now, there are various short-sighted theories about how the giants returned after The Great Flood. These include:

1. The Great Flood was not global – and so giants in other areas survived.
2. Some of the giants hung onto the outside of the ark and so they did not drown.
3. They successfully swam and treaded water for more than 150 days.
4. They clung to trees and other debris for more than 150 days and so they survived, etc.
5. BUT - - the Bible is clear. **Every creature on the entire planet** that was land based and which had ‘*breath in its nostrils*’ died.

IMPORTANT: The giants' **physical constitution** died – but not their **spiritual part**. They were hybrids – part human and part angel. Their human part died. The fallen angelic part became a 'demon,' an intelligent and evil spirit (more on this later – not today).

4. So how DID the giants return after The Great Flood? We are left with two possible answers to this question - - only TWO!
 - a. The **FIRST** option is the fallen angels had another incursion into humanity after The Great Flood **as they had done before**.
 - I have good friends and scholars in Bible prophecy that take this stance.
 - They look at a specific phrase in **Gen. 6:4** which I will emphasize here:

"There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown."

- Summarily speaking, these other scholars – and again, they are reputable guys in every respect – claim this phrase suggests the fallen angels 'CAME IN to the daughters of men' BEFORE and AFTER the Great Flood.
- This clearly happened once before - - and so these folks feel it probably happened this way again.
- If it worked the first time – then it worked the second time.

NOTE: However, I feel this is unlikely, and here are some basic reasons why I feel this way:

- **2 Peter 2:4-5**, and **Jude 6** make it plain that God severely punished this group of fallen angels; He made an example of them. I doubt others would do the same thing after that.
 - Furthermore, Satan had already played that card, and it failed. He didn't succeed in his objective.
 - Also - nowhere in the Bible does it state that fallen angels tried AGAIN to have relations with human women as they did in **Gen. 6:1-4**.
 - While various scholars and prophecy experts go with this option, I think it is unlikely, and it lacks Biblical support.
 - In fact, I personally think the fuller counsel of God's Word discourages this line of thinking. That's MY view.
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- b. The **SECOND** option is there was a stowaway on the ark – that means the Nephilim gene somehow made it onto the ark, and it re-emerged in some way **after** The Great Flood.
 - This is the only logical option left for us to consider, and as we will see, it is the option to which the Scriptures give strongest support.
 - Various other prophecy experts and scholars go with this option. I am one of those.

5. So -- the BIG question here: **“How did this happen?”**

NOTE: Again, let's establish some logic and some common sense here.

- a. Jesus came from the lineage of Noah and his wife – that means Noah was genetically pure and so was his wife.
 - The fallen angel seed had not corrupted Noah or his wife (as we already learned, the Bible makes this very clear).
 - Noah was physically unblemished – his genome was pure. Noah was found to be *“perfect in his generations.”* This was true for his wife too.
- b. That means Noah's three biological sons were also genetically uncorrupted.
 - We also know this to be true because Jesus Christ came from the lineage of Shem.
 - Jesus Christ, if He was to be God in the flesh (and of course, **we absolutely KNOW that He was**), then He could not have any corrupted human genome in His bloodline.
- c. I want you to see that we are painted into a corner here. There is only one option left to explain the return of the giants.
 - And it is a reasonable option to consider. It is this: one or more of the wives of Noah's sons was a latent carrier of the Nephilim gene.
 - She may not have physically manifested the outward evidence of this fact, but her own genetic constitution had been – in some way – corrupted within her past lineage.
 - Again – we know it was not Shem's wife, because Jesus Christ came through that branch of the family tree.

B. Now here's where things get interesting – the Bible shows VERY clearly it was the lineage of Ham that the Nephilim returned from.

NOTE: So, we can ALREADY conclude - from what we ALREADY know - that Ham's wife was the culprit carrier. I believe this is the view that makes most sense.

NOTE: I encourage each of you to go to Ryan Pitterson's YouTube channel and explore his *Beginning and End Nephilim Series*. There are multiple videos and resources, and he goes into this position in great depth. I will do a surface review today.

1. Right off the bat – we need to understand something about the ‘pattern of God’s Word.’

- Within a “prescribed portion” of Scripture, when the Bible gives an emphasis to something in a way it does NOT give to something else – **it's because God's Word wants us to take special notice.**
- It's the Bible's way of saying, *“Look here! There is something significant happening right here. Pay attention!”*
- And it does this with Ham in **Gen. 9:18-19.**

“The sons of Noah who came out of the ark were Shem, Ham and Japheth. (Ham was the father of Canaan.) These three were the sons of Noah, and from them the whole earth was populated....”

- Did you see it? Did you pick up on the **special emphasis** the Bible gives Ham? (I’m going to mention that phrase, ‘**special emphasis**,’ a few more times, so pay attention whenever I do....)
 - Right away – as soon as the Bible introduces Ham after The Great Flood – he is mentioned in parentheses as being “*the father of Canaan.*” His brothers get no such **special emphasis**.
 - (BTW, this passage I just read is ANOTHER insight into the Great Flood’s **global** impact. This passage says it was from these three sons that ‘*the whole earth was populated.*’ That means there were no other survivors.)
2. As we will see, Canaan, Ham’s son, clearly carried the Nephilim gene.
- Again, we need to use logic here: this could only happen if Ham’s wife was the carrier on the ark.
 - We can see reasonably easily, in Scripture, that Ham was morally corrupt. He did not follow God the same way his father and brothers did. The Bible wants us to pick up on that fact.
 - So – being the rebellious sort of son he was – it’s not surprising that Ham took a wife from the pagan, fallen, hybrid Nephilim culture around him.
 - Again, this doesn’t mean Ham’s wife was a giantess, or that she outwardly showed that she was different, but she was – at some physiological level – a carrier of a latent Nephilim gene.
3. I think this is why Noah pronounced a curse on Canaan in a curious story found in **Gen. 9:20-26.**
- This is the story where Noah got drunk and naked after The Great Flood (BTW, this is proof that Noah was not spiritually ‘perfect’ as some like to claim he was).
 - Ham, in some sort of depraved intent, “*looked on his father’s nakedness,*” and made it public.
 - There are various theories about what this means, what exactly Ham did, and so on. None of that really matters to our present discussion.
 - What the Bible wants us to see here is there was a difference in moral character between Ham and his two brothers.
 - Shem and Japheth, by contrast, respected their father in a way Ham had not, and so they covered Noah up.
 - When Noah regained his proper frame of mind from his hangover, he pronounced a curse – but not on Ham! Noah pronounced a curse on Ham’s son, Canaan.

- I personally think, by this point, Noah knew things were not right with Ham's kids.
 - We can only guess as to all what Noah suspected, but it was sufficient for him to pronounce a curse on Canaan (**Cf. Gen. 9:25-27**)
 - Noah makes Ham's lineage subordinate to the lineages of his brothers.
4. IMPORTANT: From this point forward, the Bible calls out and gives **special emphasis** to the descendants of Ham.
- The Bible does **not** emphasize the lineage of Shem, from which comes Jesus Christ - - but instead, Ham!
 - You can read the lineages of Ham, Shem, and Japheth in **Gen. Ch. 10**. The content devoted to Ham's descendants is roughly 2X the content of Shem's and Japheth's descendants combined.
 - As you read Ham's lineage – you will see the names of all the tribes that the Israelites encountered and fought against as they entered the Promised Land - - which was known THEN as the land of 'Canaan.'
 - These descendants of Ham are the tribes God instructed Moses and Joshua to utterly destroy (*i.e. Deut. 20:16-17, Et al.*).
 - Why? The Bible shows in several places and several ways that they were giants. Ham's descendants were Nephilim.

NOTE: For example – **Amos 2:9** describes the Amorite giants as being ‘*tall as cedars and strong as oaks*,’ and we see in **Gen. 10:16** that they were descended from Canaan. Goliath was a ‘Philistine,’ and we see in **Gen. 10:14**, that the Philistines were descendants of Canaan. I’m barely scratching the surface of all the connections like these that can be made.

- The point is, the Bible is reinforcing a vital fact here that first came up in the ‘protoevangelium’ in **Gen. 3:15**.
- God wants you and me to see how this ‘*hostility between the physical seeds*’ is taking shape. This starts in **Genesis** and goes into **Revelation**.
- Scripture therefore shows us HOW the ongoing Nephilim scourge manifests from Point A to Point B.

NOTE: Then - - we see that **special emphasis** again. It is the first grandson of Ham who receives this **special emphasis** in **Genesis 10:6-12**.

- His name is Nimrod, and Nimrod, like Ham and Canaan before him, receives a greater proportion of content -relatively speaking.
- Nimrod is **Cush's son**, and he is an unusual character in several ways. **What do we know about Nimrod?**

NOTE: I’m going to say some things here that I need you to **remember**. At some point down the road in this series, we will look back on what I’m teaching you now.

- Nimrod is the first Biblical type (representation) of the future and final antichrist. He is recorded as the first murderer and conqueror in the post-Flood world.
- He was the Founder and Ruler of the city of Babylon, which – throughout the Bible, and all the way up through **Revelation** – is known as the center of satanic idolatry, and the origin of all pagan religions.
- Babylon (originally, ‘Babel’) was founded on the plains of Shinar. It’s a part of the world which subsequently became ancient Assyria.
 - IMPORTANT: This is an area north of Israel (including northern Syria, and parts of Turkey and Iraq).
 - The Bible also makes the case that this will be the place of origin for the final antichrist.
 - We’ll study this issue much more – later - but one such passage is **Micah 5:6-7** which presents Jesus Christ as Israel’s future Messiah and conqueror OF the antichrist. It reads:

“And He will be our peace when Assyria invades our land and tramples our citadels. We will raise against it seven shepherds, even eight leaders of men. And they will rule the land of Assyria with the sword, and the land of Nimrod with the blade drawn. So He will deliver us when Assyria invades our land and marches into our borders....”

- **But notice:** the Bible connects the final antichrist with the territory and the person of Nimrod (We’ll have much more interesting info on these details in future lessons).
- Now, Nimrod led the effort to build the famed tower of Babel, a structure that was an attempt to access the fallen angelic realm once more through occultic rituals.
- Nimrod was also the first ruler to try to establish a one-world governing system. Globalism.
- Nimrod himself was worshiped as a god, and he was known by other names in ancient cultures: Gilgamesh in the Sumerian culture, and Osiris in the Egyptian culture. Marduk, Apollo, and Baal were other names given to Nimrod by still other cultures, and so on.
- Nimrod shows up in the mythology of many ancient cultures; he shows up in Hungarian, Greek, Arabic, Syrian, and Armenian legends.
- There is considerable evidence that the Epic of Gilgamesh and the Greek myth of Hercules both find their inspiration in Nimrod’s life.
- Nimrod is described as 2/3 ‘god’ and 1/3 man. BTW, two-thirds is rendered in a decimal system as .666.

NOTE: There are a few other interesting details about Nimrod, but I want to draw your attention to TWO of them in particular:

- **FIRST**, in **Gen. 10:9**, it says: “...he (Nimrod) began to be a mighty one in the earth.”
 - ✓ The term for “mighty one” is ‘**gibborim**,’ and it is the same Hebrew term used to further describe the Nephilim in **Chapter 6 of Genesis** as “mighty men.”
 - ✓ Because I don’t want to confuse you, let me read **Gen. 6:4** again -- but this time with some clarifications:

*“The Nephilim (**rendered as ‘giants’**) were on the earth in those days—and also afterward—when the sons of God went in to the daughters of men and had children by them. They were the mighty men (**rendered as ‘gibborim’**) of old, men of renown.”*

- ✓ Gibborim is also the same term used to describe the giant, Goliath, in **1 Samuel 17:51**.

NOTE: In Matthew Henry’s Bible Commentary, in various other commentaries, and perhaps most importantly – in the Septuagint, the oldest Greek translation of the OT – it is stated that Nimrod ‘**BEGAN to be a giant upon the earth.**’

- ✓ In various ancient myths, in apocryphal literature like The Book of Enoch, and even in the way the Scriptures paint this situation, it seems Nimrod, through some means – obviously occultic - transformed himself into a hybrid giant.
- ✓ Keep in mind, this ‘transformational hybridization’ is the same goal occultists and ‘transhumanists’ have today – I want you to keep that in mind as we have our lessons ahead.
- ✓ I believe this transformational element is the better way to view **Gen. 10:9**, and it is part of the reason the Bible gives Nimrod so much **special emphasis.**

- The **SECOND** detail I want to draw your attention to is the structure of the tower of Babel.
 - ✓ I believe the illustrations of many books show this structure wrong.
 - ✓ They portray it to be an immensely tall tower, taller than anything we can imagine today -- something that “reaches to the heavens” as **Gen. 11:4** puts it.
 - ✓ I don’t believe that is an accurate representation of the physical character of this edifice, nor is it an accurate representation of its purpose.
 - ✓ The physical structure of the tower of Babel was more like an enormous terraced pyramid, also known as a ‘ziggurat.’
 - ✓ The purpose of a ‘ziggurat’ was to be a ‘stargate,’ a portal if you will.

- ✓ It was intended to be a focus of occultic activity, with the ambition of allowing humans access to the spiritual realm, and vice versa.

NOTE: This is the rational view. Think about it. When God came down to see the city and tower they were building (**Cf. Gen. 11:5**), He said, “*nothing they plan to do will be impossible for them.*” This was not God’s distress about man’s architectural talents. It was God showing concern that mankind – under Nimrod’s leadership - was trying to revive the pre-flood knowledge and achievements (which were considerable, BTW).

- So, what did God do? He executed another masterful countermove. He confused their languages. This scattered humanity all over the face of the earth (**Cf. Gen. 11:8**).
- As a result, what do we see in ancient archeology all over the world?
 - ✓ We see various similar forms of ziggurats (pyramids) -- all of them associated with evil, with spiritual darkness, and with attempts to access the ‘gods.’
 - ✓ The various ancient post-flood cultures simply took Nimrod’s ideas and goals with them wherever they went.
 - ✓ They also took with them in every part of the globe an account of The Great Flood, a story about Nimrod (renaming him as we’ve already seen), and the account that Nimrod was part ‘god’ and part man. All these accounts describe Nimrod to be a giant too.
 - ✓ And – here is something **important** - all over the world, wherever these ziggurats are found, they are also occultic and UFO hotspots (more on this later).
 - ✓ It has remained the goal of the occultic-globalist community to finish the job that Nimrod didn’t.
 - ✓ They, just like the population of Nimrod’s time, want to bring about the return of a new “golden age.”
 - ✓ They want a return to the dynamics of the pre-Flood world. They want, once again, to have the ‘gods’ come down and physically interface with mankind again.
 - ✓ You can see this precise goal in the artwork of your dollar bill. There you see the unfinished pyramid with the all-seeing / occultic eye above it.

NOTE: I’m telling you the truth: our modern world leaders greatly desire to become part-‘gods’ as Nimrod did, to return to a new ‘golden age,’ to get rid of the One True God, and to unite the world under one rule as Nimrod tried to. You need to keep all this in view as we move forward in this study series.

C. Let's get back to chasing this Nephilim lineage. Other sons of Ham are noted in the Bible for their contributions to this giant lineage too:

1. Besides Cush, there is Mizraim...

- “And Mizraim begat Ludim, and Anamim, and Lehabim, and Naphtuhim, And Pathrusim, and Casluhim, (out of whom came Philistim,) and Capthorim.” (**Cf. Genesis 10:13-14.**)
- Here we see the origin of the Philistines, from which Goliath, another giant came.
- The Philistine nation, as the Bible later shows, was a hotbed for the Nephilim gene. They were profound opponents of Israel, and they were never fully conquered as God instructed Moses and Joshua to do.
- The territory they came from was Gath. We know that same area as Gaza today, which continues to be a problem for Israel even in our times.

2. “And Mizraim begat Ludim, And Canaan begat Sidon his first born, and Heth, And the Jebusite, and the Amorite, and the Gergashite,” (**Cf. Genesis 10:14-16.**)

- The Jebusites, the Amorites and Gergashites, all cousins of Nimrod, are mentioned time and time again in the accounts of the Israelites capturing the Promised Land.
- These tribes were usurpers in the Promised Land, and they too carried the Nephilim gene.
- This is why God had to deal mercilessly with these nations and tribes. It's not that He is a genocidal God as some liberal critics claim, but rather that He was trying to scrub the Promised Land of the Nephilim curse.
- The Nephilim threatened to not only extinguish humanity before this point, but they also tried to keep the Messiah from eventually being born in Israel as well.
- This is why God gave specific instructions to Moses. He told Moses how to conquer the tribes and nations they would encounter in the Promised Land (**Cf. Deut. 7:1-3**)

“When the LORD thy God shall bring thee into the land whither thou goest to possess it, and hath cast out many nations before thee, the Hittites, and the Gergashites, and the Amorites, and the Canaanites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites, seven nations greater and mightier than thou; And when the LORD thy God shall deliver them before thee; thou shalt smite them, and utterly destroy them; thou shalt make no covenant with them, nor shew mercy unto them: Neither shalt thou make marriages with them; thy daughter thou shalt not give unto his son, nor his daughter shalt thou take unto thy son. —”

NOTE: The bottom line is God mentions the Nephilim nations by name, and we see those very nations emerging from the lineage of Ham (the Bible traces this lineage very carefully because God wants us to give **special emphasis** to it).

NOTE: I want you to see how God describes these nations to Moses and to the Israelites as “**greater and mightier than you.**”

- The physical size and military advantage were obviously on the side of the Nephilim giants.
- But God was reminding Moses that the **Lord Himself was going to supernaturally intervene** so these Nephilim giants could be defeated.
- This is why God took such offense to the report of the 10 spies who were afraid of the Nephilim - and who said the Israelites could not defeat them in **Numbers Ch. 13**.
- God was not going to permit these superhuman, powerful hybrids to dominate humanity and prevent the Messiah from coming. Biblical prophecy **would** be fulfilled!
- That’s why God not only says to destroy these nations completely, but He makes a specific point of prohibiting any marriage between them. I think that second command recalls Ham’s error.

Now -- I've only scratched the surface of this issue of the lineage of the Nephilim.

- But what I've shared is sufficient for you to see that God is showing, in Scripture, just how the enduring hostility between the two seeds of **Gen. 3:15** plays out.
 - I encourage you to research this issue yourself – the Bible make this issue easy to follow.
 - **Next week:** we see how Satan gets alerted to the fact that he can now focus on the Jews and the nation of Israel. We've – necessarily – already touched on a little bit of that today, but next week we'll see how that info gets communicated to Satan.
 - It will explain why the world hates the Jews. This is a profound **spiritual** problem, not a **political** problem.
