

A Biblical View OF THE END TIMES

PRESENT CLUES OF A
FUTURE AGENDA, PT. 1
Week #12; Feb. 22, 2026, 6PM

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Review:

1. We're getting close to winding down this focus we've had on the fallen angelic agenda and the Nephilim giants.
2. It's all been part of establishing the right foundation in our in-depth series on Bible prophecy.
3. We've seen how the **start** of prophecy in God's Word DIRECTLY impacts the **end** of prophecy in God's Word. This may not be the usual approach to how Bible prophecy is studied, but I feel it's the right approach.
4. God says in **Isaiah 46:9-10**, "*I am God, and there is none like Me, declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times things that are not yet done.*"
5. By God's design, everything is tied together – **Genesis** helps explain **Revelation**. And **Revelation** depends on **Genesis**. If we want to properly understand the future, we must properly understand the past.
6. Now, the lesson today – as well as the lesson next week – will unpack some basics of what is going on now, and what is coming.
7. These things depend **a good deal** on the things we have already learned - and so I feel we will benefit from a quick review:

NOTE: This is probably the last time I'll give this recap since we're moving onward in this series. Much more info is in the videos and lesson notes of the previous sessions:

- a. We've learned Satan's been on a mission to prevent his own destruction, and to disrupt the person and work of Jesus Christ, ever since the Garden of Eden.
 - Satan understood, from ancient times, that a Messiah would come from the physical seed of the woman; this Messiah would 'crush' him.
 - He also learned that his own physical seed would war against the human genome from that seminal point to the very end of time.
 - This 'war,' if you will, is not going to stop – not until Satan is finally 'crushed.' That tells us we can expect hints of the past to show again.
 - These were prophecies given by God Himself in **Gen. 3:15**. They form the first concepts of Jesus Christ's arrival and God's plan for salvation.
- b. Satan fired the first shot in **Gen. 6:1-4**. It was a broad shot. He tried to corrupt ALL human genetics so there would be no chance of this Messiah's arrival.

- We saw from this passage how fallen angels had illicit sexual relations with women. These fallen angels tried to breed out humanity.
 - This violation of God's created order produced the hybrid Nephilim giants who were part human and part fallen angel.
 - They were huge, strong, intelligent, violent, and utterly depraved.
 - God sent The Great Flood to destroy these giants, to reboot humanity, and to preserve His plan of salvation. It was a global catastrophe.
 - The human part of these Nephilim giants died in The Great Flood. However, their fallen angelic part – their 'spiritual element' – endured as 'demons.'
- c. But the giants returned after The Great Flood – Satan continued to fight.
- The giants likely returned through the lineage of Ham. The Bible records Ham as Noah's most wayward son.
 - More specifically, I feel the giants returned through Ham's wife. This is the position the Bible appears to underscore.
 - Ham's wife was likely a carrier of the Nephilim gene – and so from Ham came all the tribes and nations of post-Flood Nephilim which the Bible lists and tracks back to Ham repeatedly and methodically.
- d. Moreover, the Bible gives significant attention to Nimrod, the great-grandson of Noah, and a descendant of Ham.
- The Bible suggests that Nimrod went through a transformative physical change.
 - He '*became a gibborim*' (in other words, a giant, or 'mighty man'). He became a hybrid – likely through occultic means. It earned him fame.
 - Nimrod tried to build the Tower of Babel, a ziggurat structure that was occultic in design, which was intended to access the fallen angelic forces once more, and which sought to unite all people under one rule.
 - But God intervened on Nimrod's plans, and God scattered the people by confusing their languages.
 - Ancient cultures around the world all tried to continue Nimrod's plans, and so we see occultic ziggurats or pyramids in all parts of the globe.
 - The intent of these structures was to provide a 'stargate' - a portal or access point whereby humans could interact directly with fallen angels from another dimension.
 - Nimrod himself became the stuff of legend and was called by many other names in other parts of the world: Gilgamesh, Apollo, and so on.
 - Nimrod's goal of accessing the fallen angels once more, of bringing back the so-called 'golden age' of the pre-Flood era, and of making humanity 'gods' in their own eyes, is the same goal of globalists today.

- That's part of the reason we see the unfinished pyramid on our dollar bill. The roots of modern globalists are occultic, and they go all the way back to Nimrod. They are just waiting for the right moment...
 - Meantime, they revere Nimrod today just as the ancient Greeks, Egyptians, Mesopotamians, Sumerians, etc. all did.
- e. When God sovereignly chose Abraham to be the father of a nation from which the Messiah would come, Satan's target got a whole lot smaller.
- Satan could now focus on destroying and oppressing Abraham's descendants, the Jews. That is still Satan's goal today – that's obvious!
 - God told Abraham in **Genesis Ch. 15** that his descendants would face these Nephilim adversaries. God lists these Nephilim nations centuries before the Israelites ever knew of them.
 - Once again, these Nephilim nations are the direct descendants of Ham. Their lineages can be traced back to him.
 - On their way into the Promised Land hundreds of years later, the Israelites encountered giants that they needed to overcome.
 - Throughout the Israelites conquests of the Promised Land, and going into the line of King David, we see specific battles and conflicts with giants and other nations that God had told the Israelites to utterly wipe out.
 - It's not that God's instructions were genocidal as some liberal scholars prefer to suggest - (they are just showing their lack of Bible knowledge).
 - Rather, this is all part of that age-old conflict which was prophesied all the way back in **Gen. 3:15**.
 - The two physical seeds were at war with each other, the Nephilim were not redeemable, they were not fully human, and they were the by-product of Satan's plans. God had to destroy them.
- f. When Jesus Christ was born and His ministry on earth began, Satan now had a face and a name. This was the Messiah that God had said would 'crush' him.
- Satan's target was now the smallest it had been since earliest times. And so there was an outpouring of demonic activity against Jesus.
 - We learned demons are not the same thing as fallen angels – the Bible makes this clear, as do some apocryphal books which the Bible quotes.
 - Demons are the disembodied spirits of the pre-Flood Nephilim. They are the unredeemable 'spiritual' element of those giants that were part human and part fallen angel.
 - These demons raged against Jesus' ministry, and they tried every way to disrupt it.
 - This Nephilim issue showed up in other ways during Jesus' ministry, and He spoke about their ancient origins and headquarters as well as their presence around Him at His crucifixion.

- Jesus also – after His death, and while being ‘alive in spirit’ before His resurrection - went and proclaimed personal victory to the imprisoned fallen angels.
 - These are the SAME fallen angels which **Gen. 6:1-4** speaks of. God had imprisoned them following their unlawful incursion into the sphere of humanity, and following their sexual relations with women.
 - Jesus let these imprisoned fallen angels know He’d won and they’d lost.
 - The books of **Jude, and 1&2 Peter** directly link these imprisoned fallen angels back to the pre-Flood era, and to their activities mentioned in **Gen. 6:1-4**.
 - And so, the zenith of our salvation – the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ – is ALSO a juncture that acknowledges this original ‘seed war.’
- g. Now – this is IMPORTANT. We’ve arrived at **all** these conclusions by sticking with the proper Biblical rules of interpretation:
- We’ve interpreted all Biblical words and phrases by their meaning in their original language (be that Hebrew, Greek, or Aramaic).
 - We’ve stuck to interpretations that agree with what all other Biblical passages are saying on the same subjects.
 - And finally – we’ve adhered to interpretations which conform to the development of the context.
 - Because we have **consistently** done these things, we can rest assured that we have not forced the Bible to mean something it is not saying, nor have we overlooked what it IS saying.

NOTE: None of this means Satan’s seed war against humanity is done. I mentioned that a moment ago...

- It is not the end of Satan’s efforts to destroy the Jewish people and the Jewish nation. The worst (by far!) is yet to come!
- Satan’s pride and personal delusion is alive and well. He STILL thinks he can defeat Jesus Christ and prevent his own destruction.
- It’s not the end of the Nephilim agenda that was first prophesied in **Gen. 3:15**. Remember, there is no end to this conflict between Jesus and Satan until Satan is finally ‘crushed.’

NOTE: Now it’s time to step back a couple paces and gather in a few more elements that help to clarify where things are and where they are going. The various things we see taking place in the world today are all linked. The beginning impacts the end.

NOTE: Imagine you are putting together a puzzle.

- Here’s a piece – or perhaps even a cluster of pieces that have been put together – those are parts of the bigger picture.

- By themselves, they don't give the full picture. Other pieces of the puzzle still need to be found to link all these elements together into one final visual.
- That's what we are going to do today – we are going to start laying out the pieces and the sections of the puzzle that ultimately come together to form the final big picture.
- We will see that the Nephilim agenda threads through some of these puzzle pieces – in some more clearly than others, but it's there all the same.
- So, let's start laying out the various puzzle pieces we know and we can recognize. These are the things that are clear. Around these, we can then start filling in the rest.

A. First, there is the fact that Daniel explains in *Dan. 2:43* that “...they will mingle themselves with the seed of men” (NOTE: I briefly mentioned this last week, and I want to say more about it today).

1. Here, Daniel is explaining King Nebuchadnezzar's vision of the great metallic statue to the King of Babylon.

- This statue represents, in its different layers, the major Gentile empires of human history INsofar as they hold significance with the nation of Israel.
- The Bible does not focus on nations as they relate to each **other** (i.e. China and the US), but it focuses on nations as they are concerned **with** Israel.
- These metallic layers in the King's vision descend in value from top to bottom: gold, silver, bronze, iron, and finally an iron and clay mixture.
- Daniel, in **vs. 43**, is explaining to King Nebuchadnezzar the meaning of the ten toes of the statue which are comprised of a mixture of iron and clay.
- The head of gold represents Babylon; that was during Daniel's time. The toes, by contrast, represent the final phase of mankind's history on earth; that's a time still future to you and me.
- Before the toes, it's all pure metals, but the ten toes (feet and toes) are a blend of two unrelated and incompatible substrates: iron and clay.
- Daniel, at this point in this book which bears his name, is writing in Aramaic. It was the official political dialect of the Babylonian empire at that time.
- The Aramaic word for seed here is “*bizra*” which is synonymous with the Hebrew word “*zera*” used in **Gen. 3:15**.
- Like “*zera*,” it means physical seed. This Aramaic term is used only once in the Bible, and it is right here.
- It means exactly what it says: it means a physical or genetic element. It reinforces the same intentions and meaning of **Gen. 3:15**.

2. Now, Daniel positions “they” and “men” as two different sources. This should not be overlooked.

- “They” is one group. “Men” is another group. And at the very end of time, Daniel says these two genetically distinct groups will mingle.
- He adds one more element to consider, and that is this: that mixture, or that blending, will not work out well.

- Something goes amiss. Despite the blending of these two seeds – however that will take place – the outcome is it will not “hold together” (as some translations say).
- But the key takeaway here is Daniel prophesies the very end of the age will be a time when two very different genetic sources are forced into some sort of blended mixture.
- OK, that’s ONE puzzle piece - - now set that one aside. Here’s another...

B. Jesus said in *Matt. 24:37* and in *Luke 17:26*, “...as it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man”

1. Jesus made this statement when He was here on earth the first time, so this statement is not a reference to His First Coming, but to His Second Coming.
2. Jesus could have chosen any point in history to liken His physical Second Coming to, but He chose the pre-Flood conditions to describe how things will be on earth when He returns at the end of the Tribulation.
3. ***Gen. 6:5*** describes the pre-flood conditions from a depravity standpoint. ***Dan. 8:23*** describes the end-Tribulation conditions from a depravity standpoint.
 - Both verses describe two different timeframes – one past and one future.
 - Both describe sin and depravity in terms of MAXIMUM expression - - meaning, there is no more room for any more sin and corruption. I unpacked this at some length last week.
 - Both timeframes are identified as being “like each other” – for example, Jesus saying the end will be “like the days of Noah”
 - The common bond between this time of the past and this time of the future is what ***Dan. 2:43*** says: “*They will mingle themselves with the seed of men.*” That happened before – in the ancient past.
 - In other words, I believe it takes another **fallen angelic incursion** (one more time) to fully marinate and deceive mankind into a state of sin and corruption that is – again! - of MAXIMUM expression.
 - OK, that’s another puzzle piece - - now set that one aside too. Next.

C. Then, there is the use of the term “beast” to describe the antichrist (NOTE: I mentioned this issue briefly in one of our Q&A sessions a few weeks ago.)

NOTE: Some people think I am making more of this particular issue than it warrants; I initially suggested this issue about ten years ago in an article I wrote called ‘*Superheroes and Superheresies.*’ You can find this article on our website.

NOTE: But today, there are others who are now thinking this way. This is a point that is worth our consideration.

1. The general conclusion in the church today is that the antichrist is called “*the beast*” because of his behaviors and conduct.

- When the media describes a mass shooter, or a serial rapist (etc.), the perpetrators are sometimes referred to as a “beast,” or a “monster.”
- They are using a ‘zoomorphism.’ They assign animal-like characteristics to a human. (Here’s another example: “She moved ‘catlike’ as she walked through the boulders.”)
- It seems most people feel this is what the Bible is doing when it calls the antichrist ‘*the beast*’ – they think this term illustrates his behaviors.

2. I don’t think that is what is happening.

- In **Rev. 13:18**, it says, “*This calls for wisdom. Let the person who has insight calculate the number **of the beast**, for it is the number **of a man**.*”
- Here, the antichrist is called a “beast,” but he is also referred to as a “man.” The Bible clearly has no problem describing who and what he is.
- The antichrist is also called the “**man of lawlessness**” in **2 Thess. 2:3**, and this final apocalyptic leader is referred to by proper pronouns many times: “He, his, him,” and so on....
- By the way, this is one of the key reasons why I do NOT subscribe to the notion that the ‘beast’ is some sort of economic or technological system. That’s a popular theory these days, but that is not supported in Scripture.
- The bottom line is the Bible clearly identifies the antichrist as a male figure - - so why are there so many references which also call him a ‘*beast*?’

3. The Greek term for ‘beast’ here is “*therion*” and it literally means a wild beast or a creature - it is used to describe a physical non-human entity.

- For example, the term ‘*therion*’ is also used in **Rev. 6:8**. This verse describes the fourth seal judgment (the pale horse of death) – and it says,

*“I looked, and there before me was a pale horse! Its rider was named Death, and Hades was following close behind him. They were given power over a fourth of the earth to kill by sword, famine and plague, and by the **wild beasts** of the earth.”*

NOTE: There’s lots of meat in that verse, and we’ll be unpacking it all in a future lesson.

- But note, the same Greek term “*therion*” (or ‘beast’) is used here again. It describes entities that are intentional and deliberate at this future point.
- These creatures directly contribute to the widespread death of humanity during a future time known as the fourth seal judgement.
- There are various theories on what these ‘beasts’ of the fourth seal are:
 - Dr. John MacArthur suggests that they are rats and vermin and germs and such that typify the standard range of diseases that follow mass disruption, war, and chaos.

- Other scholars suggest that following the Rapture the ‘lions, and tigers, and bears’ of this world will somehow ferociously turn on humans – together with dogs, cats, parakeets, and hamsters.
 - ✓ Their notion is that this will be a time when spiritual depravity will even affect the animal kingdom, and therefore the ‘beasts’ are part of the agents who will mass-kill mankind.
 - ✓ It’s certainly possible that demonic possession of the animal kingdom may be a dynamic that will come to play – I just don’t think that is the most sensible conclusion to draw when we consider the meaning of the original language.
 - I think - at this point anyways – that the ‘beasts’ of **Rev. 6:8** are one of two things, or both of them:
 - They are Nephilim in some form – they are beings who are not fully human, and are therefore acting violently and destructively, just as they did before “*in the days of Noah.*”
 - ✓ The Book of Enoch, which the Bible quotes, describes the Nephilim of pre-Flood times as killing and destroying much of humanity.
 - ✓ They were bloodthirsty, ruthless, murderous, and even cannibalistic – and perhaps they will be again.
 - ✓ Remember, Daniel said “*they will mingle themselves with the seed of men*” once more – and Jesus said it would be like the ‘*days of Noah*’ again. **So that’s one possible answer.**
 - The other possibility is that cryptids are being suggested (think Bigfoot – I think this is a physical manifestation of the dark side rather than an elusive ape species).
 - This could also involve chimeras (blending of animals and humans) that may once again see a major resurgence due to angelic meddling – just as The Book of Enoch outlines happened before.
 - Some of these entities may be very violent against the human race.
 - ✓ Remember, this dynamic was present before. **Gen. 6:12** says, “*...for all flesh had corrupted its ways on the earth.*”
 - ✓ God desired that all creatures reproduce “*after their own kind*” in the original created order of things, but many legends (which generally originate with an element of truth), the apocryphal books, and even the Bible itself, suggest things did not always conform to this divinely ordained pattern.
 - ✓ Many ancient pagan cultures revered creatures that were part-human and part-animal. The Egyptians are well-known for this. There may be good reasons for that....
4. All this said, my present thoughts are that the term ‘beast’ (or ‘therion’) is used to describe the antichrist – NOT for his depraved behavior patterns, but for his **physical composition.**

- The Bible does not make a habit of trying to portray sin or extreme depravity by using zoomorphic approaches. It just states the plain facts about sin plainly.
- Furthermore, we've ALL sinned and fallen short of the glory of God. We are ALL condemned by our sinful nature.
- We would ALL be lost if it was not for God's grace and His gift of salvation – and it is our greatest responsibility in THIS life to accept Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. We will be eternally condemned if we do not.
- So - I think the term 'beast' is used to describe the antichrist in order to suggest a specific physical consideration ABOUT HIM that is apart from extreme sin, or apart from his depraved behaviors.

5. My ideas here about the antichrist are supported another way –

- At the conclusion of the Campaign of Armageddon, the beast AND the false prophet are captured alive and thrown directly into the lake of fire (hell); **Cf. Rev. 19:20**

“But the beast was captured, and with it the false prophet who had performed the signs on its behalf. With these signs he had deluded those who had received the mark of the beast and worshiped its image. The two of them were thrown alive into the fiery lake of burning sulfur.”

- This is an insight of **profound significance** for the following reasons:
 - They are the first two recorded occupants of the eternal lake of fire.
 - They are captured and thrown into it while **bypassing** The Great White Throne judgement
 - IMPORTANT: ALL of faithless humanity from ALL ages of human history is required to show up at The Great White Throne judgement (**Cf. Rev. 20:11-15**)
 - This singular event will take place BEFORE any of them are thrown into the eternal Lake of Fire.
 - The only exceptions to this are the devil and his angels for which hell is also prepared (**Cf. Matt. 25:41**).

NOTE: Satan will also be tossed alive into the lake of fire right **after** the 1000-year Millennial Kingdom, and he will be the third recorded occupant. He does not go through the Great White Throne judgment because he's non-human.

- That also implies that the antichrist AND the false prophet are either (a.) non-human, or (b.) not fully human.
- And this all ties into the mark of the beast. We know it eternally damns those who take it (**Cf. Rev. 14:9-11**)

- Here is my view: the mark of the beast is more than a simple choice from which you can repent.
- It's not like all other decisions throughout human history **after which** one might receive grace and mercy from God.
- For some reason, taking the mark of the beast has irreversible consequences. You take it - - you're 'toast.'

NOTE: At this point in time - I believe those who take the mark OF THE BEAST are taking into their bodies some component that physiologically alters them.

- Right now, I think it changes their DNA structure sufficiently, so they are no longer 100% human. They are no longer 100% 'in the image of God' as they had been before.
- And therefore – just like the Nephilim giants before and the antichrist and false prophet, these people who take the mark are not redeemable anymore.
- They made the choice to worship the antichrist, to be like him, and to believe all kinds of lies (we'll be studying this more later).
- But for our purposes now, this future population will have allowed their bodies to be invaded by some element which – I believe – is “mass produced” from something that is PART OF the antichrist.
- This is the 'mark OF the beast' after all, and it changes them to be more **in his image**. Satan is always trying to imitate Jesus Christ.
- The result of this is – besides being altered genetically in some way – is their bodies adversely react to this element (**Cf. Rev. 16:2**).

“The first angel went and poured out his bowl on the land, and ugly, festering sores broke out on the people who had the mark of the beast and worshiped its image.”

- It's not much different than what we are starting to see today.
 - The 'so-called COVID vaccine' was never a vaccine. It was never intended to HELP anyone, and if you open your eyes and do your own research – that much is very clear!
 - Rather, the COVID 'vaccine' was a test run. It was something that more and more researchers are now admitting was designed to promote cellular change and gene alteration.
 - I personally think this technology is in a relative 'infancy' stage, but I believe it is developing very quickly – much faster than we realize!
 - (And trust me on this one) – the elites and the globalists would like nothing more than to do another 'test run' to see if they have improved any of their technology since the first go-round.
 - They already achieved the 'deception' part quite well – I've seen plenty of folks wearing their mask while driving alone in their car.

IMPORTANT: The present COVID ‘vaccine’ and its boosters are NOT the mark of the beast, but I believe they are early precursors or prototypes of a larger globalist ambition. They are a rehearsal run for total public control and conformity.

- I believe they are part of a globalist agenda that someday will RESULT in the forced mark of the beast upon the world’s population.
- Do NOT be deceived by the modern healthcare system. It is not designed to help you as much as it is designed to keep you sick and dependent. Marcus Welby is long gone, and so are the philosophies of that former era.
- Our entertainment industry has been corrupted for decades – so has our educational system and our financial system. Their agendas are not good.
- In more recent times, the medical community has joined those corrupt ranks as well. Much of the healthcare system now is downright EVIL.

NOTE: These are all some of the pieces of the puzzle we need to consider in the future expressions of the Nephilim agenda.

NEXT WEEK: We’ll tie it all together, and we’ll see how the final Nephilim agenda includes **the following issues** as part of its plan:

1. UFOs – yes, there **are** UFOs, but I don’t believe they are really ‘unidentified.’ They are signs of the dark side that have been largely kept under wraps till now, and they will soon be out in the open.
2. The climate change agenda – this will be one of the key elements of a final one-world false religious system.
3. The new age cult – they are already predicting the arrival of ‘aliens,’ and the message these ‘aliens’ will have when they arrive closely parallels Biblical truth, but it twists that truth to be convincing and deceptive instead.
4. THE LIE – this is a powerful delusion that God sends to those who have rejected the truth. Many who remain AFTER the Rapture will believe THE lie. The Bible is clear. (What IS that lie, and how does it tie all the way back to ancient times?)
