Review:

- We are winding down this foundational study into the Nephilim agenda. I know for some of you it's been new information. You've never been taught this stuff before.
- But – as we've seen - properly understanding this “seed war” which was declared by God back in **Gen. Ch. 3**, and which FIRST shows up in **Gen. Ch. 6**, is a key framework for understanding the larger themes of Bible prophecy which follow.
- We're now looking at some of the puzzle pieces that form **the future** of these same issues. We started this process last week.
 - FIRST, we saw how Daniel explains in **Dan. 2:43** that *“they will mingle themselves with the seed of men.”*
 - ✓ This is a prophecy about the very end of time, **right before** Jesus Christ's return.
 - ✓ Daniel positions “they” and “men” as two different sources, and he says these two separate sources will become blended.
 - SECOND, we saw that Jesus said in **Matt. 24:37** and in **Luke 17:26**, *“...as it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man.”*
 - ✓ Jesus said specific conditions on earth at the end of human history would be like they were at the earliest parts of human history.
 - ✓ A common component between the two timeframes is likely a physical return of the fallen angels – and the **type** and **extent** of depravity that goes with that.
 - THIRD, we studied the Greek term *“therion.”* That is the root word underneath calling the antichrist “the beast.”
 - ✓ We saw how that word is used to describe “a creature.” It is used also in **Rev. 6:8** for the Fourth Seal to describe ‘beasts’ that will be empowered and directed – even **willful** - to kill human life.
 - ✓ We noted why this term ‘beast’ is probably not a ‘zoomorphic’ description of the antichrist's behaviors.
 - FOURTH, we saw how the antichrist AND the false prophet are both captured alive and thrown into the Lake of Fire as hell's first two documented occupants in **Rev. 19:20**.
 - ✓ We noted they will both bypass the Great White Throne Judgement which ALL faithless humanity from all ages is required to attend.
 - ✓ This is a huge clue that the antichrist and the false prophet are either (a.) not human, or (b.) not fully human.

- ✓ They could start out human, but **Revelation** gives us clues that they undergo a change.
- ✓ We'll get to that later – but perhaps this also recalls what happened to Nimrod, and why the Bible gave Nimrod's life some emphasis.
- FIFTH, we saw those who take the Mark OF the Beast are simply not making a bad choice from which they can later repent.
 - ✓ Rather – it is far likelier they are choosing to do something **to themselves** from which they are subsequently unable to repent. It's no longer any issue of God's grace and mercy.
 - ✓ I believe they will not be able to turn back from this decision since their choice to take the MOB changes them **physically**.
 - ✓ This is most likely why the angel in **Rev. Ch. 14** warns them that taking the Mark amounts to a one-way ticket to hell.
 - ✓ I have stated that my personal **current** conclusion is those who take the MOB are taking **into their bodies** an element OF the antichrist.
 - ✓ In effect – I believe the Mark makes its recipients 'hybrids,' just like the antichrist will be by that point.
 - ✓ Another way of looking at this is: the recipients of the MOB are remade – in some fashion - 'in the antichrist's image.'
 - ✓ They will WANT to be remade this way. It is a total worship of the antichrist, and an irreversible rejection of the One True God.
 - ✓ But taking the MOB causes those who do to break out in painful sores (**Cf. Rev. 16:2**). Physiologically, it doesn't work out so well – maybe this alludes to what **Dan. 2:43** also says.
 - ✓ Regardless, I think taking the MOB likely results in sufficient and willful genetic alteration so that those recipients of it are no longer 100% in the image of God.
 - ✓ They choose to take themselves off the playing field - - and that's why they become unredeemable.
 - ✓ This sort of genetic alteration technology is being developed today. This is not a hidden matter anymore, and it recalls '*the days of Noah*.'
 - ✓ I personally believe the COVID vaccine was the earliest 'test run' of all this, and various scientists are now also affirming these details.
 - ✓ Remember, the giants were unredeemable. They were a corruption of God's created order. They were genetic violations which were not in the image of God either.

NOTE: These are not all the puzzle pieces we could consider as we contemplate how the past Nephilim agenda may manifest in the future, but they DO provide some strong clues.

Today, in **Part 2** of "**Present Clues of a Future Agenda**," we will try to tie all these together as we continue this fascinating portion of our study. We'll have **Part 3** next week.

A. For today, I want to consider the question, “What is THE lie?” (To understand this question, look at **2 Thess. 2:11-12.**

“For this reason, God sends them a powerful delusion so that they will believe the lie, and so that all will be condemned who have not believed the truth but have delighted in wickedness.” (NIV)

NOTE: Most translations refer to this as THE lie. Other translations get close, like saying ‘**these lies.**’ The operative point is it’s a specific deception or a group of closely related lies. It’s not general ‘lies’ or general ‘deceptions’ – but it is positioned as something more specific.

1. We must first properly grasp the context of these two verses. Turn to 2 Thessalonians Ch. 2. We’ll be giving some close attention to this chapter.

- In **2 Thessalonians 2:1** we are told something very specific – and we need to be attentive to it.
- This verse is a topical sentence for what follows in that chapter. It sets the tone – and it concerns the Rapture of the true church.

*“Concerning the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ **and our being gathered TO Him**, we ask you, brothers and sisters,”*

- ✓ Here, Paul systematically moves from his key point (the Rapture), into those events and considerations which then FOLLOW the Rapture.

NOTE: Why is Paul even bringing this matter up? The answer is seen in vs. 2:

“...not to become easily unsettled or alarmed by the teaching allegedly from us—whether by a prophecy or by word of mouth or by letter—asserting that the day of the Lord has already come.”

- It’s very important to see WHAT is going on here and WHY Paul is writing all of this to these new believers.
- **Paul is contending against falsehoods.** He’s responding to ideas that are not true, but they’ve still found a way into this new church. These things are confusing folks.
- The errant notion is this: some folks were starting to believe that they were already in **“the day of the Lord.”** This phrase means ‘the Tribulation.’
- There were people in this new Thessalonian church which had come to believe – due to things they were seeing around them, due to various persecutions they were experiencing, and due to things they’d been told by others – that they were already IN the Tribulation.

- It's not much different than folks today who mistakenly believe we are in the Tribulation right now – or that the Rapture will take place AFTER the Tribulation and all Christians must go through it.
- That's all part and parcel of what these Thessalonian believers were wondering. It's why they were alarmed. But Paul says, **"That's not true!"**
- And then he goes on to explain why.
 - ✓ For example, in **vs. 3**, he says, *"Don't let anyone deceive you in any way, for THAT DAY will not come until THE falling away (or THE apostasy) comes first..."* (NOTE: this is a very important verse, and we'll be studying it in much more depth later in this series).
 - ✓ Paul is saying, you cannot be in the Tribulation (*'that day'*) because something hasn't happened yet.
 - ✓ And that 'something' is the 'falling away,' 'the apostasy,' or 'the rebellion' (per our various English translations).

NOTE: For today's purposes, there are two primary theories on what **verse 3** is alluding to.

1. The first theory is this is referring to the Rapture.
2. The second is this is referring to a profound doctrinal erosion within the church.

NOTE: I'll give you my high-altitude thoughts on both theories since we'll be unpacking these things much more later on...

- For today's purposes, I will tell you that I lean in the direction that Dr. Andy Woods and some others do. The Greek term *'apostasia'* is most likely used here, as it is used elsewhere in the NT, to describe a **physical** departure rather than a profound **spiritual** decline.
 - ✓ This would be consistent with the intent and context of **2 Thess. Ch. 2**, particularly with the topical theme of **vs. 1** where Paul is focused on *"...our being gathered to Him."*
 - ✓ Again, Paul issues a 'topical sentence' here. He pivots from the things he WAS talking about in **Ch. 1** to a NEW matter in **Ch. 2**. And that new matter is all about *'our being gathered TO Him.'*
 - ✓ There is a directional element we need to consider here. Jesus isn't coming DOWN in this verse. This does not refer to His Second Coming. Paul says we will be gathered TO HIM!
 - ✓ It's the same thing Jesus said in **John 14:3**, *'I will come back and take you to be with me, that where I am, you may be also.'*
 - ✓ Paul is clearly referring to the Rapture. It makes sense that his follow-on thoughts in **2 Thessalonians Ch. 2** unpack this issue even more.
- The second theory is that the Greek term *'apostasia'* is being used here to describe a profound doctrinal erosion. This view is harder – in my estimation – to conclude.

- ✓ This may BE the right way to look at it, but doctrinal erosion has always been a problem with the church.
- ✓ It's a major problem right now! But – this is a relative assessment. There's no standard on this issue, and there is a lot of debate about it.
- ✓ There have been times - as in the Dark Ages - where this kind of doctrinal decay due to the Catholic Church was intense and endemic. It virtually suppressed all Biblical truth for a lengthy period of time.
- ✓ All that said, I DO think that there will be a profound and clear move away from true faith AFTER the Rapture. We will learn that there will be a rapid onset of a global false religious system at that point.
- ✓ I think this will start to happen in an unknown gap of time BETWEEN the Rapture and the start of the Tribulation (more on all this later).

NOTE: Regardless which one of these theories is the best one to camp on (maybe both at the same time), I want you to observe that 'THAT day' (which is a clear reference to the Day of the Lord, AKA 'The Tribulation') will not arrive until after the '*apostasia*' comes.

- ✓ The big takeaway here is this: this 'falling away,' or this '*apostasia*,' must happen BEFORE the man of lawlessness (the antichrist) can be revealed.
- ✓ This '*apostasia*' must happen FIRST before '*the day of the Lord*' (the Tribulation) can come. These are the points Paul is emphasizing.
- ✓ So - - bluntly stated:
 - The Rapture ('*our being gathered to Him*') is the FIRST thing that needs to happen. It's the next big item on the prophecy agenda.
 - AFTER that, the antichrist appears, and THEN, after THAT, the Tribulation (or '*the day of the Lord*') starts.
 - So, Paul's point to us is, you CANNOT be in the Tribulation because certain things need to happen first – namely, the Rapture and the appearance of the antichrist.

NOTE: We are going to get into all of this in much greater depth in future sessions, but for now, let me state the following. I believe the Bible teaches clearly that there is an order to all this:

- ✓ **First**, the Rapture takes place. It's imminent. It could happen at any time.
- ✓ **Second**, that means the restraining ministry of the Holy Spirit, working through the church, is suddenly out of the picture (***Cf. 2 Thess 2:7***).
- ✓ **Third**, those developments permit the conditions for the revealing of the antichrist - - and at some point thereafter, the onset of The Tribulation (again, we're going to do a deep dive on these issues later).

NOTE: All that is some background stuff. It all supports what I NOW want you to focus on for rest of today's session. We're still knitting all these puzzle pieces together....

- This departure of the church – ‘the Rapture’ - is a pivotal event that **sets up THE LIE** in **2 Thess. 2:11**.

“For this reason God sends them a powerful delusion so that they will believe the lie”

- THE lie is one and the same with *“a powerful delusion”* mentioned just before in that same verse. They are basically two sides of the same coin.
 - ✓ Whatever this *‘powerful delusion’* is - whatever THE lie is - it is precipitated by the supernatural removal of the church by God.
 - ✓ Paul makes this order and these ramifications clear.
 - ✓ And this *‘powerful delusion’* called THE lie is contrasted in **vs. 12** with *“the truth.”* That’s an important point we need to see:

“...and so that all will be condemned who have not believed the truth but have delighted in wickedness.”

- ✓ Whatever this *‘powerful delusion’* is, it will suppress God’s Word. It will war against the truth and it will contend with the facts. It advances a depraved and godless message instead.
- ✓ So - - that’s a look at the context. This helps us understand THE lie (also known as the *“powerful delusion”*).

2. Here is something else we need to consider about THE lie.

- It is indeed a very persuasive, compelling, and powerful delusion. I believe it reinforces that adage, *‘Seeing is believing.’*
- That adage will be very much at play here (the folks who are left behind – the people who missed the Rapture - will see something that causes them to believe THE lie). Their visuals - their senses - will convince them.

NOTE: This raises an obvious question, “What will they see or perceive?” or “What alternate message or lie will they encounter AFTER the church has been removed from the earth?”

- Whatever it is that they perceive, it will condemn them **IF** they choose to believe it and remain *‘in wickedness’* (according to **vs. 12**).
- We get some hints about THE lie in **vs. 9 of this same chapter**. Look at it.
 - ✓ In **vs. 9**, the subject of the antichrist’s political rise is discussed.
 - ✓ We see the arrival of the antichrist is accompanied by supernatural phenomena (*counterfeit miracles, signs and wonders, and the works of Satan*).

- ✓ Said another way, the arrival of the antichrist on the world scene is not a run-of-the-mill political splash, or typical back-room deal.
- ✓ In fact, it is not defined by any normal political processes. There's nothing NORMAL about the antichrist's arrival. It is paranormal!
- ✓ It is also a **'process'** – as we will later learn more about. It's going to take a period of time for the antichrist's role to be consummated.
- ✓ And that process includes various supernatural events, counterfeit miracles, fraudulent signs and wonders, a heavy infusion of the paranormal, and *'every sort of evil that deceives those who are perishing'* (**in vs. 10**).
- ✓ All these dynamics contribute to THE lie – folks will start seeing things and experiencing things.
- ✓ They will start to believe it all because it's all very convincing.

HERE'S A VERY IMPORTANT QUESTION: "Who is most vulnerable to believing THE LIE?"

- The Bible describes them in **vs. 10** as those *'who are perishing.'* That's a broad assessment. These people are ON the path of being eternally condemned.
- They are further described in **vs. 12** as people who have *'not believed the truth,'* and they've *'delighted in wickedness.'* **Two things are said there:**
 - a. First, they have not welcomed the truth of God's Word. They have made conscious choices against it.
 - b. Second, they would rather do things their own way. They've made choices to stay in darkness. They want to conform to this world's ideas and tenets.

NOTE: There is no doubt in my mind that this group includes those who have flatly rejected the Gospel, who have despised God's laws and values, and who do all they can do to elevate depravity.

- See **Rom. 1:18-20** as a clear example. This reads like today's news.
 - ✓ Here we see a group of folks who hate God's people, they hate any 'restraining influence' of righteousness and virtue, they embrace utter lawlessness, and they support others who are like them.
 - ✓ We see a growing population of people today that want to believe anything BUT the truth. They abhor common sense and logic.
 - ✓ I have no doubt that this group will fall victim to a *"powerful delusion"* that God sends to them instead. They will want to believe THE lie over THE truth.
- **There is a second group of people we may not typically think about, but I feel they are just as vulnerable to believing THE lie.**

- ✓ This group is from within the church. There may be people you know **right now** that will end up being part of this second group.
- ✓ God’s Word makes it very clear that there are ‘*many*’ in the church who are not truly saved. That includes leaders **and** congregants.
- ✓ In multiple passages of God’s Word, it states that many folks in the church are ‘tares,’ ‘wolves,’ ‘apostates,’ and ‘false believers.’
- ✓ One of the most terrifying passages in all the Bible is found in **Matt. 7:21-23**. Here we see ‘*many*’ who had imagined they were saved - - and they find out too late that they really were NOT:

“Not everyone who says to me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. Many will say to me on that day, ‘Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name and in your name drive out demons and in your name perform many miracles?’ Then I will tell them plainly, ‘I never knew you. Away from me, you evildoers!’”

I WANT YOU TO NOTICE SOMETHING: These peoples’ resumes are full of prophetic utterances, deliverance ministries, casting out demons, and fixations on various miracles, signs, and wonders, but Jesus tells them, *‘I never knew you. Depart from me you evildoers.’*

NOW I NEED TO SAY SOMETHING – I’d be irresponsible if I did not. These sorts of activities mentioned in **Matt. 7:21-23**, are EXACTLY the primary obsession of many charismatic and ‘new apostolic’ churches today which are quickly increasing in number. They are ALL ABOUT **precisely** these sorts of things.

- ✓ I find these folks are often not well grounded in doctrine – and they don’t WANT to be! They push back fiercely on it, and they mock those who accurately teach the full counsel of God’s Word.
- ✓ They heap up for themselves teachers who will ‘*say what they want them to say.*’ They embrace ‘experience-based’ faith rather than ‘truth-based.’
- ✓ But beyond **Matt. Ch. 7** - - we find in **Jude, 2 Peter, Revelation** and other parts of Scripture the same terrifying point: many who believe they are truly saved - TRULY AREN’T.
- ✓ I think a high percentage of this second group **from within the church** will quickly embrace THE lie too.
- ✓ They won’t want to believe they’ve been wrong this whole time. That’s human nature - - we don’t want to be wrong!
- ✓ This second group will believe that since THEY are still here on earth, and since they still feel they are ‘Christians’ - - it must **not** have been the Biblical Rapture that was responsible for removing millions of people from this planet.

- ✓ Consequently, they **too** will want to believe anything BUT the truth – that’s because the truth confronts their longstanding choices and preferences.
- ✓ In other words, they are NO DIFFERENT than the first group.

NOTE: So, let me just cut to the chase here - - I firmly believe “aliens” will show up almost immediately AFTER the Rapture.

- a. Now, obviously - - I don’t believe in ‘aliens,’ but I DO believe in fallen angels who can show up in whatever form and motive they choose. We’ve already learned about that. It happened before, in **Gen. 6:1-4**.
- b. I believe the case is becoming stronger every day that there will be a dramatic and convincing return of the fallen angels - and some form of the Nephilim element - into the sphere of daily human experience.
- c. I believe this will happen - almost immediately after the Rapture. It serves no purpose for these dark entities to delay this manifestation and the deceptions that go with it.
- d. **This is also consistent** with **Dan. 2:43** where it says, *‘they will mingle themselves with the seed of men.’*
- e. **It is consistent** with Jesus saying a time is coming that will be *‘like the days of Noah.’*
- f. **It is consistent** with the rise of the antichrist being *‘accompanied by the work of Satan, displayed in all kinds of counterfeit miracles, signs, and wonders.’*
- g. **It is consistent** with the antichrist and false prophet not being human, or not fully human.
- h. **It is consistent** with the post-Rapture timeframe being ‘paranormal’ in nature and not ‘normal’ like things are now (we’ll learn much more about all this later).

I believe this return by the fallen angels after the Rapture will accomplish the following:

1. They will enter the physical affairs of mankind as they did once before *‘in the days of Noah,’* they will disclose themselves without any limitations as they did in times past, and they will interact directly with the ‘earth dwellers’ who are left behind (NOTE: ‘earth dwellers’ – more on this later).
2. They will convince those who are left behind - *“those who refused to love the truth and so be saved”* - that God is just a myth or concept, and not a reality.
3. They will persuade mankind that God did not create the heavens and the earth, but THEY did instead - - and now they have returned once more to properly manage it all.
4. These fallen angels will convince unregenerate humanity – including many who still imagine themselves to be ‘Christians’ – that **they** seeded humanity on this earth, and that they – and perhaps other intelligent lifeforms in other galaxies - were responsible for the things we see around us in this Creation.
5. They will reveal themselves (**and** their prodigious and impressive technologies) as coming from another galaxy, or star system, or whatever.
6. I believe, that because they will claim something to the effect that they put humanity on this earth in far ancient times, they will also claim they removed those true Christians who were unable or unwilling **to evolve to the next level**.

7. Notice, this all meshes well with the evolutionary mindset. Unfortunately, various studies show that 10%-50% of Christians today believe in the heresies of evolution.
8. The chief motive of the return of the fallen angels is to deceive mankind. They will do all they can to explain away the Rapture. They cannot – and they WILL not - allow the Biblical truth of what **actually** happened to gain any root.
9. **This all constitutes THE lie**, and I feel it will serve to advance a ‘*powerful delusion*’ that will deceive many people. It comes down to that old adage, “Seeing is believing.”
10. I also feel that a big component of their argument at this future time will be the earth needs to ‘heal, recover, and enter a new age.’
11. They will say that none of this would be possible with all the fuddy-duddy Christians and their conservative, nationalist, backwards influence hanging around.
12. Keep in mind, this whole kind of thinking aligns very well with today’s liberal ‘earth dwellers.’ It aligns very well with their ‘climate change religion’ which has infected millions of globalist-socialist-progressives who embrace these lies already.
13. Our own nation has been decimated economically, morally, and socially by the radical climate change adherents that believe they need to save Mother Earth from humanity. I’ll be saying more on these things later...
14. **But I am certain of one thing:** the unsaved / depraved world will quickly come to celebrate the departure of millions of true Christians they have come to see as standing in the way. We see these sentiments even now...

NOTE: I believe the arguments for my claims and statements are not only made in Scripture, but it is the same case that is being made in the secular world today.

1. It’s on the evening news now. You can find this case being made on Fox News, on CNN, Breitbart News, Huffington Post, MSNBC, and so on.
 - They are all now saying the same thing. They are admitting UFOs (now called UAPs) are NOT from planet earth. They are admitting that these phenomena are ‘not human technologies.’
 - Governments are now making documents and files **public** which have been hidden for many years. These things **prove** our government has known it is dealing with interdimensional entities that are NOT from this earth.
 - I believe all these things are being put out into the public now – little by little – a bit at a time (drip, drip, drip) – to gradually condition those who will be left behind after the Rapture.
 - Now – I don’t think they know they are doing all this for THAT reason – but Satan knows! He’s pulling all the strings behind the scenes.
 - None of these disclosures are being put out there RIGHT NOW to explain away the Rapture - - because that has not yet happened.
 - Rather, these people DO believe a day is soon coming when ‘aliens will show up,’ and they are doing their part now to prepare the world for their arrival.

2. Meantime, the movie and entertainment industry has been doing ‘superhuman work’ (pun intended) to ALSO condition the masses.
 - They promote story after story of superheroes, ‘gods’ from other galaxies, magnificent figures coming to earth to save humanity from its crises, etc.
 - Everything concerning this message is now aligning. I see all the ads on YouTube for gaia.com now - - and they’re actively promoting new movies and series which advance the idea that aliens seeded us here on earth, how they are going to come back to rescue us, and so on.
 - It’s interesting to note that a couple of these ‘documentary’ series develop the idea that these aliens will appear as ‘god-like’ beings who will arrive on massive triangular motherships all over the globe.
 - They portray these ‘aliens’ as beautiful beings of total beauty and perfection - appearing in all iterations of present cultures and humanity: blond, brown-skinned, muscular, athletic, well-dressed, loving, intelligent, compassionate, etc. etc.
 - Literally, for the past three decades, this concept of ‘superhumans and god-like beings’ coming to earth to save us from ourselves and to restore the earth has been THE MOST dominant theme in the movie industry and on various online forums.
 - It started all the way back with the earliest comic books, but now a couple of generations have grown up being indoctrinated with these false notions.

3. This idea is **not only** supported in the Bible, it’s **not only** made clear in the evening news, and it’s **not only** the dominant theme of the entertainment industry, but here is something VERY important - it is **also** a key teaching of the New Age Movement.
 - Douglas Hamp, a prophecy expert and author I have communicated with, and Brad Myers, a research expert in Biblical prophecy that I have had multiple discussions with, both document this same thing at great depth.
 - They both provide evidence that dark spiritual entities are – right now! - sending consistent messages to leaders within the New Age Movement and to those who embrace ‘global cosmic consciousness’ (NOTE: the aforementioned Gaia website is a key PR tool for these folks).
 - These entities are falsely claiming they are ‘aliens,’ and they are stating that the earth will soon go through a period of cataclysmic changes.
 - The descriptions they give are very similar to the Biblical events of the Tribulation.

NOTE: I’m going to read now from their writings and ‘revelations.’ These dark entities are specifically saying the following to these New Age leaders movers-and-shakers (and again – I’m quoting verbatim):

- ✓ ***Cataclysmic events will come upon the earth***
- ✓ ***THEY will help us overcome those events***
- ✓ ***They will take those that can’t or won’t evolve to the next level***

- ✓ ***Those that remain get to evolve to the next level now***
- ✓ ***A man from among us will be raised up with special powers and knowledge***

NOTE: Let me read you an excerpt from Barbara Marciniak. She is a popular New Age author and acclaimed ‘channeler.’ In other words, she’s a medium – an occultist.

In her book ‘*Bringers of the Dawn,*’ she records messages which she claims to have directly received from extraterrestrials from the star system ‘Pleiades.’ In her book, she discusses the disappearance that is going to come upon the world. She says:

“The people who leave the planet during the time of Earth changes do not fit in here any longer, and they are stopping the harmony of the earth. When the time comes that perhaps 20 million people leave the planet at one time, there will be a tremendous shift in consciousness for those who are remaining.

*(She continues) If human beings do not change – if they do not make the shift in values and realize that without Earth they could not be here – then Earth, in its love for its own initiation and its reaching for a higher frequency, will bring about a cleansing that will balance it once again. **There is the potential for many people to leave the planet in an afternoon.** Maybe then everyone else will begin to wake up to what is going on.”*

So, what’s our takeaway here? It should be clear to us - **not only** from what the Bible says, **not only** from the gradual release of information by governments, **not only** from the conditioning agenda of the entertainment industry, and **not only** from New Age leaders themselves - that Satan and his legions are ALREADY making preparations to have an alternative explanation for the Rapture.

- The devil knows God’s Word. You can see he knows the Rapture is coming. You can also see that he intends for people who are ‘left behind’ to not believe in the Biblical doctrine of the Rapture.
- If they did, that would result in many people’s repentance. It would result in people adhering to the foundational truths of God’s Word. It would result in strong faith, comfort, hope, encouragement, and so on.
- These are the same reasons Satan – via ‘*doctrines of demons*’ today, keeps many pastors and churches from properly teaching on the Rapture now.
- I personally believe all these deceptions that Satan and his fallen angels intend to push after the church is supernaturally taken out of this world comprise THE lie that **2 Thessalonians 2:11** speaks clearly of.
- And all these lies will be marinated in a stew of ‘*counterfeit miracles, signs, and wonders*’ (Cf. **2 Thessalonians 2:9**) in order to try to convince people.
- It is within this stew of supernatural deceptions that the antichrist will arise.

NOTE: It’s worth noting here that The Vatican has been massively funding programs, infrastructure, telescopes, and other technologies to seek out “alien life” for years now.

- More recently, the Catholic Church leadership has stated that they expect aliens to show up here soon, and when they do, they will be worked into the practices and rituals of the Catholic faith.
 - They are already planning to baptize the ‘aliens’ when they arrive. The last Pope made that clear. REMEMBER ALL OF THIS FOR LATER IN THIS SERIES!
 - The book of **Revelation** makes it plain that there will be - after the Rapture – the rise of a one-world false religion that will sweep all cultures and societies. It will be an oppressive and persecutory false religion. NO dissensions will be allowed!
 - I believe it will mostly be an amalgamation of the heresies of the Catholic religion, the climate change deception, and occultic New Age philosophies (again - - we will be studying these matters in-depth in lessons to come).
4. It’s not hard to put two and two together to see the problem. The picture is gaining focus, and there is a huge conundrum here – and it’s mounting:
- The majority of pastors and churches today have rejected or diminished the doctrines of Biblical prophecy. The result is...
 - ✓ Most Christians today (**and** most who wrongly believe they are saved) are unable to responsibly perceive the present times - or properly defend the truth about what is coming.
 - ✓ Not knowing what is right or wrong, not knowing what to believe, not knowing truth from lies, some of these people will also discover they are false ‘Christians.’
 - ✓ They will also be left behind, and they will fall prey to this ‘powerful delusion’ as well because they have not been properly taught.
 - ✓ Gary W. Ritter, a minister and author, wrote in one of his articles, *“I doubt if we’re even at a 20-80 split of Bible-believing churches versus those which choose their own beliefs...”*

NOTE: He is probably more right than he is wrong. Many research studies back his concerns.
