



FAITH AFTER DISCLOSURE: Exploring UFOs Through a Biblical Lens, Part 1

Special Lesson: Presented 5/17/26 (AM & PM),
and 5/19/26 PM

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Introduction:

- Every now and then, when certain things happen in our world, I feel it's best to adjust my normal teaching routines and provide a **TIMELY** special lesson instead. This will be a two-part series.
- In the last couple of weeks, there's been a social media frenzy claiming, "Our government has met with pastors and urged them to prepare their congregations for imminent alien disclosure." I have received multiple questions about this.
- I'm fortunate to have some good friends in the right places, and so I've made personal calls to get to the bottom of everything. I've talked to qualified people I trust to get the facts "straight from the horse's mouth."
- With what I've learned, and considering the many questions I continue to receive, I've chosen to 'pivot' again. This was an "11th hour" decision for me, but I feel it's the right thing to do.
- We are told in **1 Peter 3:15** to, "**Always** be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the **reason** for the **hope** that you have." If we are clueless about what is happening in our world, and if we don't know what God's Word says about these things, then we are less equipped to 'give reason for the hope we have.'

Background (here is the situation that occurred, and how it presently stands):

1. Basically, there have been two events which have **directly** contributed to all this 'buzz.' These were both meetings that took place in February of this year.
2. The **first** meeting was during the National Religious Broadcasters event in Nashville Feb 17-20 where two individuals - both Christians - who have worked in 'intelligence and special ops' – arranged to privately meet with a small group of well-known pastors / Bible prophecy 'influencers.' There were 8-10 people in attendance.
3. At this meeting these two individuals shared with these pastors some information they had concerning UFOs, UAPs, and various plans to disclose additional info to the public. This information they shared was largely 'public,' though some of it is harder to find than the rest.
4. Keep in mind, "UFO" stands for Unidentified Flying Objects; it is the acronym most of us are familiar with. "UAP" is a more recent designation. It stands for Unidentified

Anomalous Phenomena, previously known as Unidentified Aerial Phenomena. This newer classification is an attempt to present a broader, more scientific approach.

5. One of these pastors / 'influencers' in attendance to this first meeting subsequently asked for a **second** follow-on meeting in February with these same two individuals, and some additional Christian leaders were introduced to the same info. This **second** meeting had around 12-15 people in attendance. About 25 had been invited to this second meeting, but a good number of them did not come.
6. Following these two meetings, several of these pastors / 'influencers' mentioned these meetings (and what they'd learned) on their own social media platforms and podcasts, etc. Nothing really came from the release of this information.
7. However, ANOTHER pastor / Bible prophecy 'influencer' who had a much larger social media following and greater name recognition - but who himself had NOT been at any of these February events - learned of these two meetings. HE opted to talk about them to HIS followers roughly two weeks ago. He gave a more 'embellished' version of what had taken place at these meetings, and he took some 'liberties' to insinuate what their purpose and implications were.
8. Fast forward to today. NOW, social media is ablaze with various 'bombshell' reports that the government is encouraging pastors to 'prepare their congregations for what is coming,' that aliens will soon be making a major public appearance, and so on. It seems that this story is taking on more sensational elements each day.
9. Meantime, over the top of all of this, Vice President, JD Vance – in March - declared on a podcast that '*aliens are demons.*' Tucker Carlson has stated the same thing. That has resulted in many Christian leaders and social media 'influencers' parroting this view that '*aliens are demons.*'

Problems (there are several important dilemmas resulting from all this that we need to consider):

- **#1** - This notion that '*aliens are demons*' has now become a 'knee jerk' response by uninformed Christians and their uninformed leadership.
 - This falls well short of properly explaining these issues or understanding them through a responsible Biblical framework.
 - This idea lumps everything in some sort of vague 'spiritual' perspective rather than unpacking and acknowledging the clear 'physical' evidence.
- **#2** – The way this has all come about has further reinforced this view within the church that Bible prophecy and the study of end times issues amount to nothing more than 'fringe sensationalism.'
 - This only serves to further pull people AWAY from the truth rather than TOWARDS the truth.
 - It reinforces the idea to many within the church that we need to focus on LESS of the Bible rather than MORE of the Bible.

- **#3** – The events of the past couple of weeks have further cemented in the minds of the world-at-large this idea that “we are not alone.”
 - The average person on the street is now more convinced of this than they were two weeks ago - - and they’re not getting the truth.
 - Effectively, the church has become a passive ally to decades of active conditioning strategies by the media and entertainment industries.
- **(Lastly)** – Christian leaders who **SHOULD** be properly talking about these matters the **right** way are now **less** inclined to do that.
 - However, the people who **HAVE BEEN** pushing the **wrong** ideas are now doing **more** of that.
 - (And), the small crowd of **SOUND** Bible prophecy teachers are facing even **greater** resistance as they seek to provide **proper** Biblical truth.

NOTE: As I stand back and look at everything that’s going on, I feel another layer of deception has recently been slathered over the truth of God’s Word. There is nothing good about any of this, and so I have a simple outline of things I want to present this week and next week:

1. An overview of the UFO phenomenon (I’ll refer to ‘UFOs’ and not ‘UAPs’ – easier).
2. An assessment of ‘angels’ and ‘demons’ and why these are two different entities.
3. An understanding of how these issues fit into a larger Biblical framework or narrative.
4. A Biblical review of a forthcoming end times deception that is being prepared now.
5. What a responsible Christian posture to these matters needs to take into account.

A. AN OVERVIEW OF THE UFO PHENOMENON

NOTE: It is not my intention to provide an exhaustive body of facts and research here. You can look up these things on your own – if you care enough to do that. The info is there. (But) I want to make a few points by way of overview and giving a foundation:

1. While most UFO sightings are found to have another explanation (like weather or natural phenomena, hoaxes, drones, military craft, and so on), there are many cases which cannot be dismissed these conventional ways.
 - These latter cases concern **legitimate** UFO sightings, and they have been dramatically rising - particularly over the past two years since the US and some EU governments have started releasing info that was previously classified.
2. Our government has been evaluating (and covering up) multiple thousands of these latter cases since 1947, and some of the more recent events have made it into mainstream news.
 - Some of these UFOs have been clocked at doing anywhere from 5,000 to **600,000** mph - - by way of comparison, the fastest human-controlled aircraft is the experimental North American X-15 which can achieve about 4,500 mph.

- But these UFOs display unusual qualities which are beyond our own technological means: spontaneous anti-gravity lift; instantaneous acceleration; hypersonic velocities without signatures like vapor trails, heat friction, or sonic booms; abrupt acute angle turns and rapid changes of direction; visibility cloaking; and trans-medium travel (i.e. moving between water and air).
 - It goes without saying that humans – and human technology - cannot tolerate these kinds of G-forces and physics. A human pilot would turn into mush. Our best technologies would disintegrate **long before** they reached these parameters.
 - Esteemed astrophysicist **and Christian**, Dr. Hugh Ross, states these UFO qualities utterly “...*defy the laws of physics, and yet in many cases we can prove that the phenomena is real.*”
 - We need to note that these qualities about UFOs have been known for centuries. This is nothing new. Some of the earliest documentation of UFOs goes back to the time of the Egyptian Pharaohs.
 - We have much better technology now to **prove** what is being seen and how it behaves, but these types of UFO sightings have been happening for a very long time, and they have not changed much.
3. At this point in time, the most responsible question is not, “**Do UFOs exist?**” – but rather, “**What are they?**”
- It’s obvious that UFOs exist which meet all the criteria I’ve mentioned here. This rules out those predictable cliché responses that say this is military technology.
 - It’s just as clear that this phenomenon has been well documented long before the Wright brothers flew their first ‘wood-wire-and-fabric’ plane.
 - This is critical to establish, because anyone who chooses to insist otherwise – or who denies the reality of UFOs - is willfully ‘burying their head in the sand.’ They are only showing their own stubbornness and reluctance to admit the facts.
 - It’s also well-documented that fragments and parts of UFOs have been retrieved from crash sites, and these items do not conform to known elements and materials.
 - As you may also know - multiple reports indicate our government has – in its possession – **whole and operable** UFOs.
 - This is all very important to understand because we cannot write off the UFO phenomenon as something purely ‘spiritual.’ In fact, it is a **great mistake** to take this stance.
 - There is much evidence to show UFOs are **physical objects** - - OR they have the capacity to **become** physical by standards that we define and understand.
 - Putting all this more simply, multiple records plainly describe UFOs as tangible ‘nuts and bolts’ technology.

4. There is also a clear connection between occult activity and UFO sightings.
 - This is a point concerning which Christian researchers, and various non-Christian researchers agree: UFOs (again – we’re talking about **legitimate** UFO sightings). They are a phenomenon which exist **beyond** the space and time constraints of our universe.
 - As a case in point, the French astrophysicist, Jacques Vallee, who does not identify as a believer, has produced extensive research into the UFO issue. He has concluded we are dealing with **interdimensional beings** and **paraphysical phenomena**.
 - Some of our military’s top brass agree with this assessment. Recently, on Fox News (Fri. May 15, ‘26), Ret. Rear Admiral, Tim Gallaudet, said:

“I know we are aware of higher order non-human intelligence that direct the movement of these phenomena. What I do know is that the nature of some of these craft is so advanced, and so apparently are obviously under intelligent control, that the only conclusion we can make and has been made by those that I've read in these programs who I know is that there's some kind of higher order non-human intelligence directing them.”

NOTE: I could list many quotes by respected military leaders and personnel, scientists, researchers, astrophysicists, and so on – but you can look these things up for yourselves.

- The bottom line is the most credible of them agree on two things: **First**, these UFOs are paraphysical – they exist beyond our time and space limitations; they can move between our dimension and another. And **second**, they are under obvious ‘non-human-intelligence’ control.

NOTE: This brings me back to the ‘occultic’ connection I mentioned, and there are some additional elements we need to consider here.

- Where UFO encounters are concerned, a disturbing trend is seen as the encounter becomes more direct.
- Alan Hynek - an American astronomer, professor, and “ufologist” who worked on Project Blue Book – is the person who came up with the six-fold classification for UFO sightings we use today.
- At the bottom of the scale is Classification #1; this designates seeing unusual “lights in the night sky.”
- At the top of the scale is Classification #6 (AKA ‘Close Encounters of the Third Kind’ – remember the movie?), and this is defined as “a UFO encounter where an animated entity is present that is either the occupant or ‘pilot’ of the UFO.”
- In using this classification scale, records have shown it is never good when the human(s) have a close encounter. Dr. Hugh Ross stated in an interview that *“It is always deleterious.”*

- In other words, it's always harmful to the human contactees in some way. At the least, it results in recurring and terrifying nightmares, and at the worst, these contactees have disappeared, they have been injured, or they have been killed.
- Another finding that underscores this UFO-occultic connection is what these interdimensional beings are communicating - they **consistently** deny the person and work of Jesus Christ.

NOTE: For example, there is a well-known book called The Urantia Book, or The Urantia Papers. It is large - more than 2,000 pp. - and it's often referred to as 'the bible of several UFO / occultic religions.' It was written by a Chicago physician, William Sadler, over a couple of decades before it was first published in about 1955. Here is what is notable about this book:

- William Sadler said its contents were authored as a "*clearing house for the coming and going of alleged extra-planetary personalities.*"
- Trances and psychic phenomena were associated with the 'downloads' of information which these '*extra-planetary personalities*' provided.
- And roughly a third of the content of The Urantia Book is focused on denying the deity of Jesus Christ.
- **Here's another thing to consider:** UFO encounters vary across the globe. For example, there are many more UFO sightings in France, Brazil, and Transylvania where occultic practices are higher, than there generally is here in the US.
- Even within our own state of Colorado, the New Age and spiritualist headquarters of Crestone reports disproportionately high incidences of UFO sightings.
- This occultic-UFO connection is also true for Boulder, CO; Taos, NM; San Clemente, Chile; Sedona, AZ; and various other places where occultic and New Age practices are embraced. Studies have shown a consistent connection.
- It's worth noting California is the state with the most UFO sightings – and South Dakota has the least.

B. I WANT TO SHIFT OVER TO THE TOPIC OF 'ANGELS AND DEMONS'

NOTE: I really want to talk about MORE than angels and demons. Next week, I'll briefly touch on two other types of entities as well: Nephilim and cryptids. But I'll focus on 'angels and demons' today as we consider our larger topic here.

1. We need to talk about these things because, as I stated at the outset of this lesson, we have this 'knee-jerk-Pavlovian-type' reaction within the church that '*aliens are demons.*'
2. I have two initial thoughts about folks that **insist** on this view, and from what I have been perceiving about them:
 - **First, they don't know** – they are showing their lack of Biblical knowledge.

- **Second, they don't study** – they are showing they are not willing to learn.

NOTE: The bigger problem is most Christians – and most churches – believe demons and fallen angels are the same thing. They use the 2 terms interchangeably. A = B, and so B = A.

But as we will see, that's not accurate. Let's look at some background information here to help us answer this question, **“What are angels, and what are demons?”**

3. (Start with) **“What are angels?”**

NOTE: Angels were the first 'beings' that God supernaturally created. They were already present BEFORE the universe was ever created (**Cf. Job 38:7**):

“...when the morning stars sang together and all the angels shouted for joy?”

- This verse is part of a discussion between Job and God. God is talking about the time when He FIRST created the heavens and the earth, and he rhetorically asks Job if Job was there *“when the angels shouted for joy.”*
- My larger point is the Bible makes it clear that angels were created BEFORE the heavens and earth were ever created. This passage in **Job 38:7** describes a point in the very distant past before any of the angels – Satan included – had become fallen.
- The Bible **suggests** (it does not explicitly 'teach') that one-third of the original righteous angelic host rebelled with Satan and became 'fallen angels' (**Cf. various passages: Luke 10:18; Rev. 12:3-4; Isaiah 14:12-15**).

NOTE: It's important to understand that angels – whether fallen or righteous – have the same abilities. They just don't have the same standards. One group has not rebelled; the other has.

- (EXAMPLE): Jesus taught that righteous angels stay within the bounds of heavenly laws according to **Matthew 22:30**. He said they do not marry - - and they do not BECAUSE they are righteous. Their choices are the **right** ones.
- Conversely, we read in **Gen. 6:2** that *“the sons of God saw that the daughters of men were beautiful, and they married any of them they chose.”*

NOTE: I've taught extensively on this passage and on everything related to the events surrounding **Genesis 6:1-4**, and so I won't repeat those things here. You can find the videos and lesson notes for that series, *'A Biblical View of the End Times,'* on our website.

- But here are the big takeaways: the 'sons of God' in **Gen. 6:2** are fallen angels. The *'daughters of men'* are human women.
- The context shows that an unlawful sexual union took place between these two groups, and that produced the hybrid Nephilim giants (half human and half angelic).

- **Jude 1:6** and **2 Peter 2:4** tells us God imprisoned these fallen angels for what they did. They made the wrong choice to violate God’s created order of things.
- The point is angels CAN manifest in a physical form and do physical things we don’t typically imagine them to do. Fallen angels have breached God’s divine boundaries, but righteous angels stay within those bounds.
- These various PHYSICAL abilities of angels should not surprise us. Righteous angels **ate** physical food with Abraham in **Gen. 18:8**. They ate with Lot and his family, and Lot washed their feet in **Gen. 19:1-3**. They grabbed Lot and **pulled** him back into the house in **Gen. 19:11**. Gabriel touched Daniel and helped him to stand upright in **Dan. 8:18**.
- Angels can also transition between ‘heaven and earth.’ This capacity for them to be part of the heavenly realm – and to also be part of earth – is clear from **Job 1:6 and 2:1**.
- They can move between both places, and the Bible makes it clear that is true for fallen angels as well. It will not be till the midpoint of the Tribulation that Satan and his fallen angels will no longer have heavenly access (**Cf. Rev. 12:9**).
- But - a key takeaway here is angels can not only manifest in physical form, but they can blend into our earthly experiences just like we can. **Heb. 13:2** tells us, “*some people have shown hospitality to angels without knowing it.*”

NOTE: The Bible teaches us that angels are also ‘spirit’ beings in **Heb. 1:14**. The obvious conclusion from everything we learn about angels in God’s Word is they can move between two worlds or dimensions.

- They can be ‘spirit’ if they choose to be, and they can be ‘physical’ like you and I if they choose to be.
- When angels appear in Scripture, they appear as men and without wings. It’s why “*some people have shown hospitality to angels without knowing it.*”
- Nowhere in the Bible do angels appear as stunning beautiful women with glorious, feathered wings, or like chubby rosy-cheeked babies with tiny wings like we see on greeting cards. These portrayals are not Scripturally based.
- Various other angelic forms are mentioned in Scripture (Cherubim, Seraphim), but these are of a higher order of angels, and they do not appear anything like what we imagine angels to be.

NOTE: But here are the main things I want you to understand about angels insofar as this special lesson is concerned – and the Bible teaches these things are true for BOTH fallen and righteous angels:

- They can move freely between heaven and earth. They are not bound to one or the other. They can appear in God’s throne room, and they can appear in your neighborhood.
- They can take on ordinary physical form and appear like you and I. They can participate in routine physical activities and functions without any limitations.

- They can manifest in other types of physical form as needed (**Matt. 28:3; 2 Cor. 11:14; Dan. 10:4-6, Et al.**).
- They can exist as ethereal ‘spirit beings’ without a physical form.
- In other words, angels – both fallen and righteous – have almost no limitations.

NOTE: Now I want to ask the second question, “**What are demons?**” We’re going to see that this is a very different kind of entity. Demons are a lot more limited than angels.

NOTE: I’ve taught extensively that demons are the disembodied spirits of the Nephilim who were part human and part fallen angel. Again, you can listen to those lessons online; there are several lessons about this topic in that series called, ‘A Biblical View of the End Times’ (mention the upcoming live stream, starting Thur., June 11).

Here’s the quick summary:

- The part of the Nephilim giants that died in The Great Flood was their human half. It drowned like every other creature that *‘had the breath of life in its nostrils’* (**Gen. 7:22**).
- But their ‘spiritual’ part – or their supernatural part – had come by way of their fallen angelic parentage. This part could not drown like ordinary physical flesh. So, this part continued.
- This ‘supernatural’ or ‘spiritual’ part of the Nephilim became ‘demons.’ **IMPORTANT:** demons were not created by God the way God originally created all of the angels.
- Demons were not **once good**, but then they **also fell**. They were depraved from the start. Demons are a byproduct of fallen angels who violated God’s created order.

This raises the question: Does that mean that demons which are active in the world **today** are – in fact - the ‘spiritual component’ of ancient giants that Noah himself saw?

- **“Yes, that’s what we’re dealing with.”** The past is connected to the future.
- My answer is based on the weight of Biblical evidence, and upon the written views of the early church fathers (including those disciplined by the apostles).
- My answer is **also** based on information provided in the extrabiblical texts - - like the Book of Enoch which, **IN FACT**, emphasizes this position very clearly.
- The Book of Enoch is quoted in **Jude 1:14** and **2 Peter 2:4**. While the Book of Enoch is not inspired canon, it was found as part of the Dead Sea Scrolls, and it was studied and respected by the early church fathers.
- But - demonic activity is alive and well in modern times. (And) it is increasing – and it will **continue** to increase. That should not be a contested matter.

NOTE: Here is what we know about demons...

1. The Bible mentions several things about demons we should consider (**NOTE:** I have lots of Scripture references here – I won’t read them all – but they are available in these lesson notes for your own study).

- Demons can give people great strength (**Cf. Matthew 8:28; Mark 5:3; Luke 8:29; Acts 19:13-16; Et al**). They enabled people to break metal chains and to beat up a whole crowd.
- Demons can cause humans to exhibit bizarre behavior such as living in an ancient cemetery (**Cf. Matthew 8:28; Mark 5:2; Luke 8:27**) or wearing no clothes.
- Demons can cause humans to self-mutilate (**Cf. Mark 5:5**), or to harm themselves by jumping into fires or bodies of water (**Cf. Mark 9:22**).
- Demons can cause seizures and adverse body activity (**Cf. Matthew 17:14-21; Mark 9:14-29; Luke 9:37-43**),
- Demons show up in places of worship and in public places (**Mark 1:23-28; Luke 4:33-37**).
- Demons can, through a human agent, cry out with loud voices (**Mark 1:24; Luke 4:33-34; Matthew 8:28; Mark 5:5; Luke 8:28**),
- At other times, demons can prevent people from speaking at all (**Cf. Matthew 9:32-34; Matthew 12:22-24; Luke 11:14; Mark 9:17**).
- Demonic possession can also result in altered personalities and ‘dissociative identity disorders’ (DID), often called ‘multiple personality disorders’ (MPD).
 - This is not a fact that is specifically stated in Scripture, but it has been well-documented in actual cases of demonic possession.
 - The bottom line is demonic possession can cause a person to behave very differently than they behaved at another point.
 - There are other causes of mental or psychological maladies – and they are not **always** spiritual. Long term or severe trauma, abuse, or stress can result in fragmenting a person’s behavior or identity.
 - **But my point is this:** the surge in acute and chronic mental disorders in our society *sometimes* has a demonic component.
- Demons can also seem to be clairvoyant – they can appear to engage in pretty accurate ‘fortune-telling.’
 - It’s because they exist in time and space that is beyond human limitations.
 - Demons can manipulate people and circumstances to come. Think about the possessed Philippian ‘slave girl’ in **Act. Ch. 16**.
- Based upon the Biblical evidence, demons can cause various forms of sickness, muteness, deafness, blindness, insomnia, and mental illness.
- There is even record of demons causing physical deformity (like a severe curvature of the spine) in **Luke 13:10-16**. Here, an evil spirit caused a woman to be profoundly crippled for 18 years.

NOTE: When one studies all the accounts of demons in the Bible, it becomes clear that they have intelligence, personality, intention, motive, emotion, malice, fear, abilities, and desire.

2. The Bible gives us some other interesting insight about demons and their nature.
 - They are restless entities that feel thirst and distress. For example...

(Cf. Matt. 12:43-44) *“When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walks through dry places, seeking rest, and he finds none. Then he says, I will return into my house from whence I came out; and when he is come, he finds it empty, swept, and garnished.”*

IMPORTANT: Think about what’s being said about demons here. It is not describing any of the motives, behaviors, and constitution of angels – whether they are fallen or righteous.

- Various translations say these demons go through ‘*waterless, arid, or dry*’ places. They are confined to this earth, and they are restless and anguished. They are always seeking rest and reprieve.
 - This same passage also underscores that demons have a desire to inhabit some sort of physical body – like a human or an animal. It’s because demons were ONCE **one part** of a physical creature.
 - When Jesus cast out the legions of demons from the two men in the Gerasene region, the demons begged to be permitted to enter the bodies of pigs **(Cf. Mark 5:10-12)**.
 - It’s in that same account that we learn the demons also challenged Jesus, saying it was not yet their time for judgment – so here we have a clue that demons already know they are on the losing side of a grand cosmic battle. They are unredeemable – just as the Nephilim giants were.
3. Here are some other pieces of information we can reasonably **conclude**, and these things are **very** relevant to our special lesson here:
 - The idea that demons can materialize in tangible, independent, physical form is NOT supported in Scripture.
 - To the contrary, the Bible speaks of these disembodied and formless spirits going around always trying to find human beings and creatures to possess (BTW, this is not a characteristic of angels).
 - Demons need to manifest through a living body – again, like a human or an animal – or through some sort of inanimate object (like moving chairs, beds, floating cups, Ouija boards, etc.)
 - While the Bible does not expressly say this, this becomes clear when you discern all the things that ARE said about them, and what the demons themselves request (like ‘send us into the pigs’).
 - And – this is important to know, demons cannot POSSESS a true Christian (NOTE: I’ve had people tell me they knew of a ‘Christian’ that was possessed - - but that is not a TRUE Christian then!).
 - They can OPPRESS a believer (that is – they can harass and torment a follower of Christ), but they cannot bodily possess a Christian the same way they can possess a non-believer.

- I believe Jesus does not share his temple with evil spirits. The two opposing sides cannot dwell together within one individual. There is no Biblical reason to suggest otherwise.

NOTE: One premise about demons the Bible does NOT support – NOR is it suggested in any of the extrabiblical texts – is the idea that demons are specifically “here or there,” or that they carry any specific ‘sin tasks.’ Let me explain....

- It’s popular – particularly in the charismatic denominations – to label “this or that” as being caused by a demon.
- These people find demons behind every tree, under every rock, in the bathroom, in the copy machine or the microwave, etc.
- They talk about the demon of lies, the demon of lust, the demon of gambling, or the demon of envy, and so on.
- They claim there is the demon of COVID, the demon of heart attacks, sore throats, pimples and bad gas. This is ridiculous.
- Yes, the Scriptures DO teach that demons can cause illness and physical adversity.
- But - to label every normal expression of our fallen bodies and nature as ‘demonic’ misappropriates the truth of God’s Word.

NOTE: I could say much more about this topic, but time has run out. Hopefully, the Q&A time will permit me to respond to some matters I’ve not specifically addressed in this session.

NEXT TIME: We’ll have Part 2 of this special lesson, and we should be able to wrap it up then. We’ll see how these UFO / ‘alien’ issues fit into a larger Biblical framework, and we’ll do a review of a forthcoming end times deception that is being prepared right now.
